



**Step 2:** The blocks are sewn together to complete the following sets. Remember the star points do not touch with the floating points.

*Seam Lines: The stitch lines on the foundation papers, Line 1 & Line 2 do not match when the blocks are sewn together.*

**Step 3:** When joining the rows, press the seams for each row in opposing directions.

### Cutting Instructions for (1) Table Runner (19) Stars

#### Temp SS-1, Background Triangles: Small Star, Bag #1 & 2.

1. Cut (13) 3-1/2" by 42" strips from *Background Fabric #1*.
2. Crosscut the background strips into (152) 3-1/2" squares. (1 strip yields 12 squares)
3. Cut each square diagonally, corner to corner, into (2) triangles for a total of (304) SS-1 Template pieces. Place (152) triangles into Bag #1 and (152) triangles into Bag #2.

#### Left Unit, Small Star Diamond: (Medium Accent Fabric)

1. Cut (10) 2-1/2" by 42" strips. These are cut from the medium fabrics.
2. Open and stack the strips *right-side-up*.
3. Use Temp. SS-2, Left Small Star Diamond, and crosscut (8) diamonds from (9) strips and (4) diamonds from (1) strip for a total of (76) pieces. Mark the diamond pieces for the left units and place them into Bag #1.

#### Right Unit, Small Star Diamond: (Dark Accent Fabrics )

1. Cut (10) 2-1/2" by 42" strips. These are cut from the dark fabrics.
2. Open and stack the strips *right-side-up*.
3. Use Temp. SS-2, Right Small Star Diamond, and crosscut (8) diamonds from (9) strips and (4) diamonds from (1) strip for a total of (76) pieces. Mark the diamond pieces for the right units and place them into Bag #2.

#### Quarter-Square-Triangles: (Light Background Fabric)

1. Cut (3) 9-3/4" squares from the background fabric.
2. Crosscut (10) quarter-square-triangles. Set these pieces aside to use when completing the table runner.
