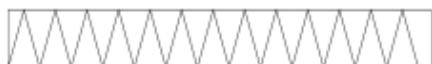


Template H-1: Background Fabric #1: Cut (2) 6-1/2" by 42" strips from background Fabric #1. Place wrong sides together. Use Template H-1 and crosscut the strip into 32 pieces. (16 left and 16 right).



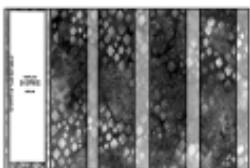
One strip yields 28 pieces.

Template H-2: Background Fabric #1: Cut (3) 5" by 42" strips from background Fabric #1. Place wrong sides together. Use Template H-2 and cut 64 pieces.



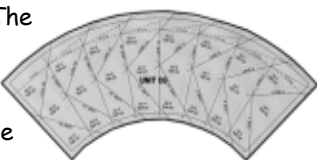
One strip yields 25 pieces.

Template H-Spike: Medium Dark Fabrics: Cut (1) 7" by 42" strip from ten different medium dark fabrics. Crosscut each strip into (26) 1-1/2" by 7" strips for a total of 260 pieces. Place 80 pieces into Bag #1 and place the other 180 pieces into Bag #3 to use with the HS-Units.



UNIT-CG: Cutting Instructions for Bag #2: Make 16 Units:

Templates CG-1, CG-2, CG-3: The templates for CG-2 and CG-3 are used with background Fabrics #2. Template CG-1 is for the geese. Place the pieces for each template into Bag #2.



Template CG-1: Dark Geese Fabrics: These pieces are cut from a quarter square triangle. Cut (32) 6" squares from five of the dark fabrics. Cut the squares diagonally into 4 triangles. You need 128 triangles for the geese.



Template HS-1: Background Fabric #3: Cut (3) 5-1/2" by 42" strips from background Fabric #3. Place wrong sides together. Use Template HS-1 and crosscut the strip into 72 pieces. (36L and 36R).



One strip yields 32 pieces.

Template HS-2: Background Fabric #3: Cut (6) 5" by 42" strips from background Fabric #3. Place wrong sides together. Use Template HS-2 and cut the strips into 25 pieces for a total of 144 pieces.



One strip yields 25 pieces.

Template HS-3: Dark Fabric: Cut (18) 4-1/2" squares from one dark fabric. Cut the squares into half square triangles.

UNIT-GPS: Cutting Instructions for Bag #4: Make 40 Units:



Background Fabric: Templates GPS-1 and GPS-2: Cut (5) 4" by 42" strips from each background Fabric #1, #2, #3, and #4. A total of 40 strips is needed. Fold fabrics wrong sides together. Use both templates to crosscut the fabric strips. Place Template GPS-1 on both the selvage end and on the fold end. Template GPS-2 is used to cut the rest of the pieces.



The graphic above show the strip open at 42" you need to fold the strips in half at 21". Each strip yields 2-L and 2-R pieces for the GPS-1 template and 18 pieces for GPS-2. **Note: If you don't get the same number of pieces shown in the graphic, then cut a couple extra strips to make up the difference.** The total number of pieces needed for these units are 80 GPS-1 pieces (40L and 40R) and 360 GPS-2 pieces.

Dark Fabric: Template GPS-2: Cut (2) 4" by 42" strips from each of the ten medium dark fabrics. Use Template GPS-2 and cut each strip into 20 pieces. A total of 20 strips is needed.



Note: If you don't get 20 pieces from your fabric strips then cut a couple extra strips to make up the difference. You need (400) GPS-2 pieces to complete these units.

Center Template JFF-4: Background Fabric #4: Cut (16) pieces from background Fabric #4. Accuracy is required when cutting these pieces. Place these pieces into Bag #5.

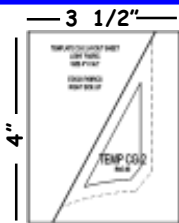
Border Corner Squares: Cut (4) 3-1/2" squares from one of the background fabrics. Place these pieces into Bag #5.

Background Strips for Applique: Background Fabric #5: Cut (12) 4-1/2" by 20-1/2" long strips from background Fabric #5. Place these pieces into Bag #5.

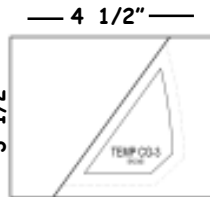
Vintage Pinecone Fabric: Cut (12) 4" by 20" long strips for the pine cone applique pieces. Place these pieces into Bag #5.

Border Strips: Medium, and Dark Fabrics: Cut (1) 13" by 42" strips from the five dark fabrics that were not used for the geese. Place these pieces into Bag #5.

Template CG-2: Background Fabric #2: Cut (6) 4" by 42" strips from background Fabric #2. Crosscut the strip into 3-1/2" by 4" rectangles. Stack the rectangles right sides up. Use template CG-2 and cut two pieces from each rectangle for a total of 128 pieces. One strip of fabric yields 24 pieces.



Template CG-3: Background Fabric #2: Cut (7) 3-1/2" by 42" strips from background Fabric #2. Crosscut the strip into 4-1/2" by 3-1/2" rectangles. Stack the rectangles right sides up. Use template CG-3 and cut two pieces from each rectangle for a total of 128 pieces. One strip of fabric yields 20 pieces.



UNIT-HS: Cutting Instructions for Bag #3: Make 36 Units:

Templates HS-1 HS-2 and HS-3: The templates for HS-1 and HS-2 are used with background Fabrics #3. Template HS-3 is cut from one dark fabric. You should already have 180 pieces in Bag #3 for the H-Spikes. Place the pieces for HS-1, HS-2 and HS-3 into Bag #3.
