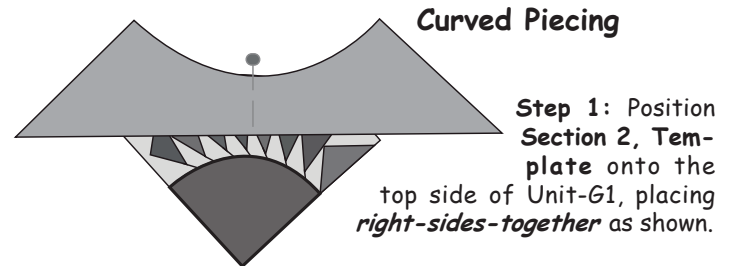
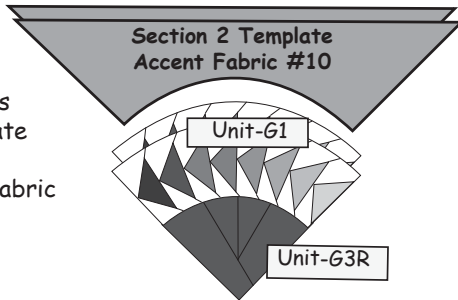


Section Template 1, 2, 3, & 4, are sewn onto the G1-Units to complete each set.



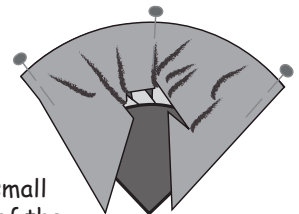

Step 2: Fold both units in half to find the centers. Use a small pin to hold the centers together. Match and pin the edges weaving both pins along the sides to hold the edges together.

Step 3: Finish shaping the top piece to match the convex edge of the bottom unit by gathering up the outer edge in your hand, forcing it to fan open and match the outer curve.



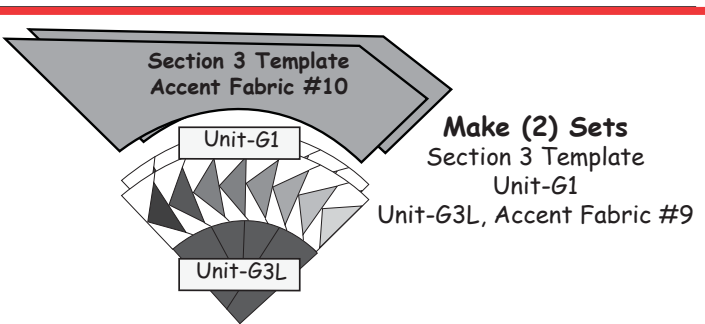
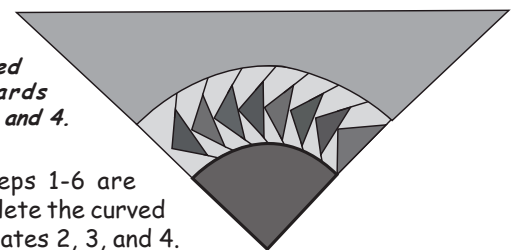
Step 4: Using a glue pen, dab a small amount of glue around the perimeter of the convex edge of the G1-Unit.

Step 5: Quickly match, shape, and press, the concave edge of the template piece up with the convex edge of the G1-Unit. The glue will hold the edges together while sewing the pieces together.

Step 6: A *quarter-inch* seam allowance is used to stitch the two pieces together. The G1-Unit is placed next to the feed dogs with the template pieces on the top next to the pressor foot.

Note: The curved seams are pressed facing out towards Template 1, 2, 3, and 4.

The previous steps 1-6 are repeated to complete the curved piecing for Templates 2, 3, and 4.
