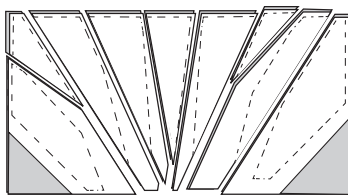


Step 3: Place your ruler on the **Template Layout Sheet**. Line up the edge of the ruler with Cut Line 1. Slice through the paper and fabrics with your rotary cutter. Continue cutting on each Cut Line, following in numerical order until all the sections are cut apart.



Step 4: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together. Separated the left and right pieces and place them back into Bag #5.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRIC #B3 (BEIGE)

► Outer Border, Units BF1, BF2-R&L & BF3-R&L (See Graphics on Page 7 and Page 8)

NOTE - COWS STANDING UP!: There are two cutting diagrams shown for Fabric #B3. Option 1 should be selected if you are not as concerned about the directions of your cows, but want to cut a solid outer border piece. If you are not using a directional fabric (such as the cows), this would be the option you choose as well. Option 2 should be selected if you want all of the cows facing as if they are standing on every border. This will require piecing the top and bottom borders to get the length you need for the edge of the quilt.

Background Fabric #3: Option 2

Step 1: Cut the following pieces from Fabric #B3, using the graphics for the Option you have chosen as a guide for where to cut the pieces from each layout of fabric:

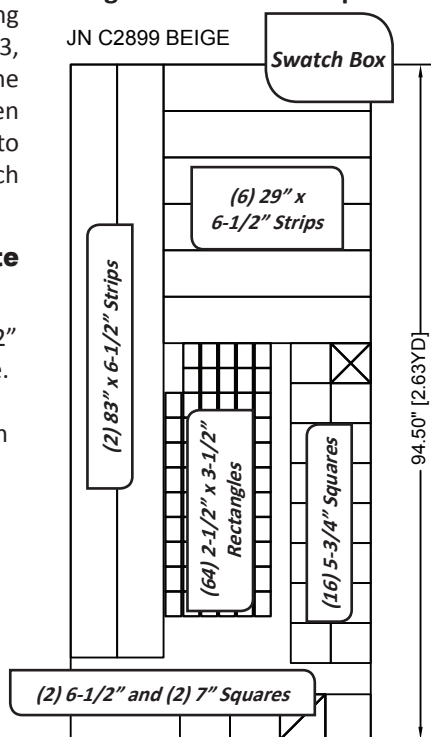
OPTION #1 (Complete cutting in order):

- Cut (1) 8-1/2" x 42" strip and set aside.
- Cut (4) 83" x 6-1/2" strips down the selvage.
- From the 8-1/2" x 42" strip, cut (2) 6-1/2" squares (**Temp BF-6**), (2) 5-3/4" squares (**Temp BF-4**), and (2) 7" squares (**Temp BF-2**).
- From the remaining fabric, cut (14) 5-3/4" Squares, clip to **Temp BF-4**.
- Cut (1) 15" x 38-1/2" rectangle, clip to **Temp BF-1**.

OPTION #2 (Complete cutting in order):

- Cut (2) 83" x 6-1/2" strips down the selvage.
- Cut (6) 29" x 6-1/2" rectangles from selvage to selvage.
- Cut (1) 15" x 38-1/2" rectangle, clip to **Temp BF-1**.
- Cut (16) 5-3/4" Squares, clip to **Temp BF-4**.
- Cut (2) 6-1/2" Squares, clip to **Temp BF-6**.
- Cut (2) 7" Squares, clip to **Temp BF-2**.

Step 2: Clip the border strips together (6-1/2" strips) and place in Bag #6.



Step 3: Stack the (2) 6-1/2" squares, **right-side-up** and cut one diagonal cut. You can use **Temp BF-6** from Bag #6 if you like to cut these pieces. You will need a total of (4). Clip together and place back into Bag #6.



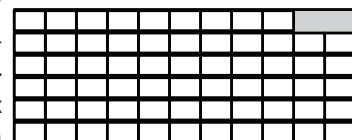
Step 4: Stack the (2) 7" squares, **right-side-up** and cut a diagonal cut in one direction, then a diagonal cut in the other direction. There is only one **Temp BF-2** in the pattern, and it is used to cut two different colors. Simply clip the (8) cow pieces together and place into Bag #6, leaving **Temp BF-2** with the pieces cut from Fabric #B2.



Step 5: Stack the (16) 5-3/4" triangles into (2) stacks of (8) squares, **right-side-up**. Cut on diagonal, then cut on the other diagonal, leaving you with (64) Quarter Square Triangles. Clip together, with **Temp BF-4** and place into Bag #6.



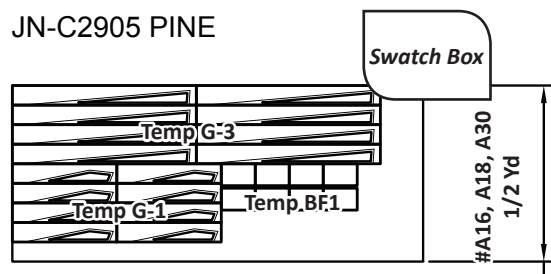
Step 6: From the 15" x 38-1/2" rectangle, cut (6) 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips. Stack these, **right-side-up**, and cut (11) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle stacks. You can discard (2) from the stack. Clip these to **Temp BF-1** and place them into Bag #6.



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRIC #A16, #A18, AND #A30 (PINE)

► Temp G-1, Temp G-3, and Temp BF-1

Fabric #A16, Temp G-3:

Step 1: Cut (4) 2-1/4" x 42" strips. Stack **right-side-up**, Then, using **Temp G-3** from Bags #4 and #5, cut (8) 2-1/4" x 19" rectangles.

Step 2: Clip (4) rectangles together and label **Unit C2-L, Sec. 8, Temp G-3**. Place into Bag #4.

Step 3: Clip the remaining (4) rectangles together and label **Unit C3-L, Sec. 8, Temp G-3**. Place into Bag #5.

Fabric #A18, Temp G-1:

Step 4: Cut an 8" x 22" rectangle. Sub-cut into (4) 2-1/4" x 22" strips. Stack these **right-side-up** and cut into (2) sets of (4) 2-1/4" x 11" rectangles, using **Temp G-1**.

Step 5: Clip (4) rectangles together and label as **Unit C2-L, Sec. 2, Temp G-1**. Place into Bag #4.

Step 6: Clip the remaining (4) rectangles together and label **Unit C3-L, Sec. 2, Temp G-1**. Place into Bag #5.

Fabric #A30, Temp BF-1:

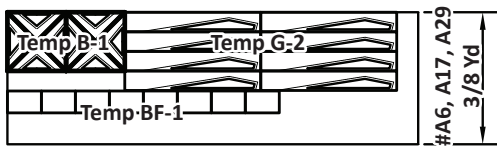
Step 7: Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 14" rectangles. Stack these, *right-side-up*. Using *Temp BF-1* from Bag #6, cut (4) sets of (2) rectangles that are 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" in dimension.

Step 8: Clip these together and label as *BF3-R and BF3-L Temp B-1, Fabric #A30*. Reserve (8) small swatches of the left-over fabric with this group of rectangles. Clip these to that stack as well, then place into Bag #6. These will be used to help you organize your colorwave for the Chevron Border later in the pattern.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRIC #A6, #A17, AND #A29 (GRASS)

► **Temp B-1, Temp G-2, and Temp BF-1**

Fabric #A6, Temp B-1:

Step 1: Cut (2) 6" Squares. Stack these, *right-side-up* and cut along one diagonal, then cut along the other. You can use *Temp B-1* from Bag #2 as a guide for cutting these if desired.

Step 2: Clip these together and label as *Unit B, Sec. 4, Temp B-1*. Place these into Bag #2.

Fabric #A17, Temp G-2:

Step 3: Cut (4) 2-1/4" x 28-1/2" rectangles. Stack these *right-side-up* and cut in half, yielding (2) stacks of (4) 2-1/4" x 14-1/4" rectangles.

Step 4: Clip (1) stack together and label these as *Unit C2-L, Sec 4, Temp G-2*. Place into Bag #4.

Step 5: Clip the remaining stack together and label these as *Unit C3-L, Sec. 4, Temp G-2*. Place into Bag #5.

Fabric #A29, Temp BF-1:

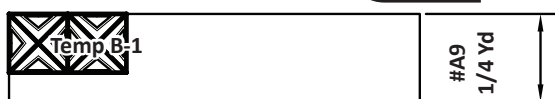
Step 6: Cut (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles from the remaining fabric, using *Temp BF-1* from Bag #6 as a guide. Clip these together and label as *BF3-R and BF3-L, Temp B-1, Fabric #A29*.

Step 7: Reserve (8) small swatches of the left-over fabric with the group of rectangles. Clip these to that stack as well, then place into Bag #6. These will be used to help organize the colorwave for the Chevron Border later in the pattern.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRIC #A9 (GOLD)

► **Temp B-1**

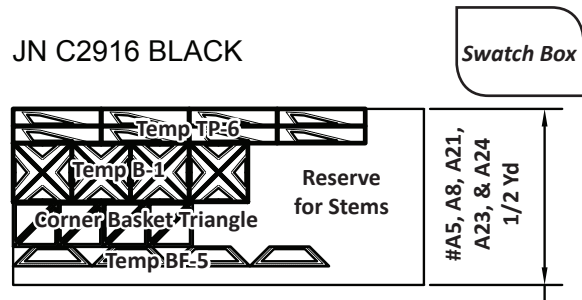


Fabric #A9, Temp B-1: Cut (2) 6" squares. Stack, then cut Quarter Square Triangles using Temp. B-1. Label as *Unit B, Sec. 13, Temp B-1*. Place into Bag #2.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRIC #A3, #A5, #A8, #21, #23, AND #A24 (BLACK)

► **Temp TP-6, Temp B-1, Temp BF-5, and Corner Basket Triangle**

Fabric #A3, Temp TP-6:

Step 1: Cut (2) 1-3/4" x 42" strips. Stack these *right-side-up* and place the *Temp TP-6* on top. Use it to cut a total of (8) Templates.

Step 2: Clip these together and label as *Unit TP, Sec. 6, Temp TP-6*. Place them into Bag #1.

Fabric #A5 and #A8, Temp B-1:

Step 3: Cut a total of (4) 6" squares. Stack these *right-side-up* and cut along one diagonal, then the other to get (4) stacks of Quarter Square Triangles. Use *Temp B-1* as a guide if you desire. Separate into (2) stacks of (8) pieces.

Step 4: Clip one stack together and label it as *Unit B, Sec. 1, Temp B-1, Fabric #A5*. Place into Bag #2.

Step 5: Clip the other stack together and label it as *Unit B, Sec. 10, Temp B-1, Fabric #A8*. Place into Bag #2.

Fabric #A21, Corner Basket Triangle:

Step 6: Cut (4) 5" squares. Stack these, *right-side-up*, then, using the *Corner Basket Triangle* from Bag #5, cut along the diagonal to get (8) pieces.

Step 7: Clip these together and place into Bag #5. Label these, if desired.

Fabric #A24, Temp BF-5:

Step 8: Cut (1) 2-1/2" x 42" strip. Lay the *Temp BF-5* from Bag #6 on top of the strip and cut (4) pieces. Clip these to *Temp BF-5* and place into Bag #6.

Step 9: Reserve (8) small swatches of the left-over fabric with the group of rectangles. Clip these to that stack as well, then place into Bag #6. These will be used to help organize the colorwave for the Chevron Border later in the pattern.

Fabric #A23, Cattail Stems:

Step 10: Reserve the leftover fabric to cut stems for the Cattail Applique, later in the pattern. Clip to the *Cattail Template* in Bag #5 and place into Bag #5.
