Bali Bed Runner

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Bali Bed Runner pattern is Judy's original Wedding Star design downsized to a 2 ring by 8 ring layout, measuring 30" x 104". This Bed Runner will makes a great wedding gift for any modern Bride in today's world. The project is small, making it affordable and easy to complete in a limited amount of time. This design has become a classic in the quilting industry and is one that continues to sell more each year than it did the year before.



One pre-packaged 2-1/2" strip set (48) count was used to complete the quilt on the cover. A link is available on our website to learn more about the Quiltworx Strip Sets. - Bag #2: (42) Unit B
- Bag #3: (32) Unit **CDS & Templates**
- Bag #4: (32) Unit • **CMS & Templates**
- Bag #5: (42) Melons & Templates

Pattern Groups

With the publication of Quiltster, Quiltworx has taken steps to reorganize many of its staple patterns based on Unit Groups. The following instructions will include cutting information, followed by piecing, and then leading to any sub-assembly information necessary to complete each Group across the pattern. For the Wedding Star, the following Groups should be completed:

Groúp B Unit CDS Group A: Unit A Group B:, Unit M Group A: Unit B Group B: Unit CMS

- Group A: Unit A and B Arcs (Chapter 1) •
- Group B: Centers and Melons (Chapter 2)

The assembly instructions are included in Chapter 3.

Foundation Papers

Replacement papers are available from Quiltworx.com to make a second Bed Runner.

The yardage and cutting instructions included in the Charts throughout this pattern only pertain to the 30" by 104" Bed Runner.

NOTE - Making this Quilt Larger: Additional layouts are available for our Wedding Star Designs. Please refer back to Booklet One for general information on how to access these patterns. If you choose to make a larger quilt, it is highly recommended that you purchase the patterns and instruction for the layout you are wanting to make instead of attempting to adapt this pattern to a larger size. The larger patterns include all the foundation papers, cutting instructions, vardage and assembly graphics for the sizes pertaining to the larger layouts.

YARDAGE SELECTION FOR THE **30" X 104" TABLE TOPPER**

Selecting Fabric: Ring Color Sets are general used to complete our Wedding Ring quilts and can be purchased as pre-packaged sets. If you choose to use yardage for the Bed Runner it will require you to cut your own 2-1/2" strips. Our yardage is based off the total inches required for each fabric color then rounded up to the nearest 1/8 yard.

Ring Colors Sets: Ring Color Sets consisting of (8) 2-1/2" x 42" strips ranging from light to dark. A total of (48) 2-1/2" strips are needed to complete this quilt. For the sample on the cover, we used (1) pre-packaged strip set with (48) different fabrics. If you choose yardage over the strip sets, you would divide the total number of strips, which is 48, by the number of fabrics chosen to get the total # of strips needed to cut from each fabric. [Example: (48) divided by (8) Fabrics = (6) 2-1/2'' strips cut from each fabric. Yardage: $6 \times 2-1/2''$ = 15'' rounded up to the nearest 1/8 yd = 1/2 yard of each fabric.

Fabric References, Back Cover, Page 20

Corner Pieces (Fabrics A1:a to A1:d): Choose (2) dark (A1:a and A1:b) and (2) medium fabrics (A1:c and A1:d) for the corners. 1/4 Yard of each fabric, A1:a to A1:d is required.

Center and Melon Backgrounds (Fabrics B1:a to B1:d): Choose (4) fabric for the background fabric. 7/8 Yard is required for each background fabric in the Bed Runner.

Center & Melon Star Accent Fabric (Fabric B2:a to B2:d): Choose (4) accent fabric for the star from a medium fabric. This will be used for Units CMS, and Unit M. 3/8 Yard is required for each accent fabric in the Bed Runner.

Center Star Black Accent (Fabric B3): Choose (1) black (or very dark) fabric for Units, CDS, and Unit M. 1-1/4 yard is required for the Bed Runner.
