

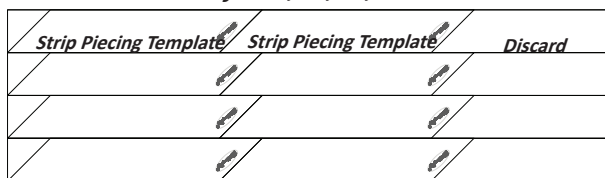

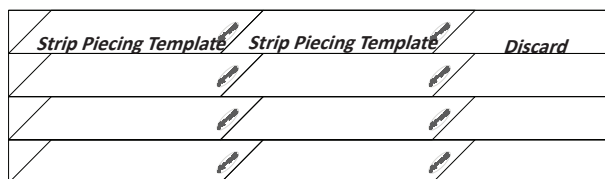

Fabric #2 Temp. Sheet S1, S2	1/4 yd (9")	Tonga-B3178 Moss
Fabric #3 Temp. Sheet S1, S3	1/4 yd (9")	Tonga-B2507 Granite
Fabric #4 Temp. Sheet S1, S2, S3, S4	3/8 yd (13-1/2")	JN-C2900 Tan
Fabric #5 Temp. Sheet S1, S3, S5	1/4 yd (9")	JN-C2906 Charcoal
Fabric #6 Temp. Sheet S2, S3, S4, S5,	3/8 yd (13-1/2")	JN-C2915 Linen
Fabric #7 Temp. Sheet S2, S4	1/4 yd (9")	JN-C2908 Grey

Cutting Strips: The cut size for each strip is 3" by 42". After the strips are cut, press and stack the strips facing **right-side-up** and place them with the noted Foundation Template Sheets.

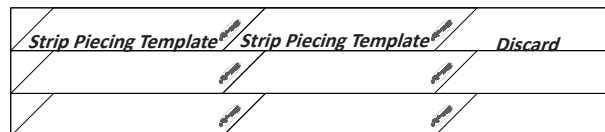
1. Fabric #4: Cut (4) 3" by 42" Strips. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S1, S2, S3, S4.



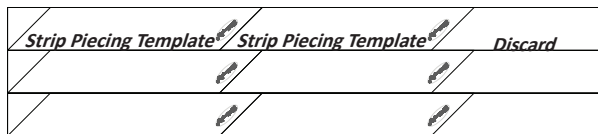
2. Fabric #6: Cut (4) 3" by 42" Strips. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S2, S3, S4, S5.



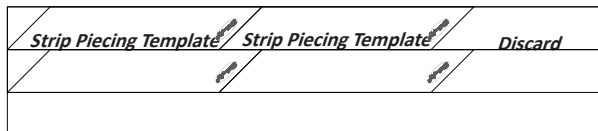
3. Fabric #7: Cut (3) 3" by 42" Strips. Place two strips with the Foundation Sheets for S2. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S4.



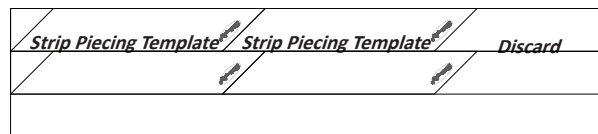
4. Fabric #5: Cut (3) 3" by 42" Strips. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S1, S3, S5.



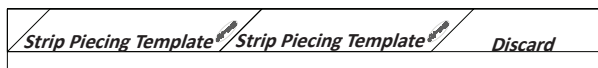
5. Fabric #3: Cut (2) 3" by 42" Strips. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S1, S3.



6. Fabric #2: Cut (2) 3" by 42" Strips. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S1, S2.



7. Fabric #1: Cut (1) 3" by 42" Strips. Place one strip with the Foundation Sheets for S1.



Open, Press, Stack & Cut: The *Strip Sets* for each Template Sheet are pressed open and stacked facing **right-side-up** in the order shown on the following page. Position both **TWM Strip Piecing Templates** as shown onto the top layer of each stack and cut (2) sets from each strip. Clip the **Strip Sets** together in the order they were stacked and clip them onto their respective Foundation Sheets. The end pieces are discarded but don't throw them away. You may need them if you make a cutting mistake.

NOTE - Keep Track of your Color Placement: A small fabric swatch should be cut from each of the end pieces and glued onto each foundation sheet in the order the colors are sewn. This will help you keep the colors in order as you sew the strips sets onto the foundation papers. The Foundation Sheets have been labeled with both Sec. #s and Fabric #s.
