Step 5: Stack the (3) strips and subcut (17) pieces using the Spike Template A from each of strip. Place (50) pieces into Bag \#1 to use with the A-Units. The colors will alternate around the Spikes when sewing the units together. You will have some leftover.


## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, UNIT B: BAG 2

Step 1: Cut (1) 6-1/4" $\times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip from Fabric \#B1. Subcut into (1) $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (1) $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


Step 2: With the rectangles right-sideup, position the Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet for Sec. 4, 5, and 6 onto the $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Use the TLS as a guide to cut the diagonal, then restack the pieces from both sides, place the TLS on top, and beginning on Cut Line 1, move numerically through the TLS until it is cut apart.

Step 3: Repeat that same process using the Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet for Sec. 1, 2, and 3 with the $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
 $\times 18$ " rectangles. (Graphic at top of next column).

Step 4: When the cutting is complete, clip the pieces together


Step 6: Stack the strips and subcut (5) pieces from each using Spike Template B. Place the pieces from each color into Bag \#2 to use with the B-Units. (Note that you will only need a total of 10 ). The colors will alternate around the spikes when sewing the units together.

INSTRUCTIONS, UNIT C: BAG \#3
Step 1: Cut (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips from Color C1. Stack the strips and cut (3) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles from each strip. Reserve (10) for the next step and discard the rest.


Step 2: Stack the (10) rectangles, right-side-up. Place the Unit C Background Template Layout Sheet for Temp C-2 on top of the stack.


Step 3: Place a clip on each Sec. Template, then cut on the Cut Lines,
