


Step 2: Stack the strips and cut (16) pieces matching the size and shape of *BCTR Unit A Background Template A-3* found in Bag #1. Place these pieces back into Bag #1.




► **Table Runner: Background Fabric B1**

Step 3: Cut (8) 5-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric B1.



Step 4: Stack the (8) strips facing *right-side-up* into (1) group. The strips are cut using the *BCTR Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet* found in Bag #2.



Step 5: Using a ruler and your rotary cutter, sub-cut (16) pieces matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet.




Step 6: Clip each layout sheet onto (8) fabric pieces around the perimeter of each stack and complete the cutting, following the Cut Lines in numerical order on the layout sheet. Place these pieces back into Bag #2.



► **Table Runner: Background Fabric C1**

Step 7: Cut (1) 2-1/2" by 42" strip from Fabric C1. Position the strip facing *right-side-up*. Using the *BCTR Unit C Background Template Layout Sheet* found in Bag #3, sub-cut (4) pieces to match the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet.



Step 8: Clip the layout sheets to the fabric strips around the perimeter of each stack and cut apart on the Cut Lines in numerical order on the layout sheet. Place these pieces back into Bag #3.

► **Table Runner: Accent Fabrics A2 (a-b-c-d).**

Step 1: Cut (1) 6-1/2" by 42" strip from each of the (4) Accent fabrics listed for Fabric #A2.



Step 2: Press and stack the fabric strips facing *right-side-up* into one group of (4) strips.

Step 3: Position the *BCTR Unit A Accent Template Layout Sheet* found in Bag #1 onto your stack and cut (4) pieces from each strip, matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet. (Total=(16) Pieces)

Step 4: Clip the layout sheets to the fabric strips around the perimeter of each stack and complete the cutting following the Cut Lines in numerical order on the layout sheet. Place these pieces back into Bag #1.



► **Table Runner: Accent Fabric B2**

Step 1: Cut (3) 4" by 42" strips from Accent Fabric B2. Press and stack the fabric strips facing *right-side-up* into one group. Position the *BCTR Unit B Accent Template Layout Sheet* found in Bag #2 onto your stack.



Step 2: Cut (16) pieces matching the size of the Template Layout Sheet.



NOTE - (5) pieces are cut from Strip 1 and 2, (6) pieces are cut from the bottom strip

Step 3: Clip each layout sheet onto (8) fabric pieces around the perimeter of each stack and complete the cutting, following the Cut Lines in numerical order on the layout sheet. Place these pieces back into Bag #2.



► **Table Runner: Accent Fabric C2:**

Step 1: Cut (4) 3-1/2" squares from Fabric C2. Or, reserve yardage and cut it from any of the leftover Background pieces. Place into Bag #3.

PILLOW TOPS: CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cutting Your Fabric: The Pillow Top cutting instructions only include the written information. Please, refer back to the Table Runner Cutting Instructions for the cutting graphics.

► **Two Pillow Tops: Background Fabrics A1**

Step 2: Cut (2) 4-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric A1.

Step 3: Press and stack the fabric strips facing *right-side-up*. Use the *BCTR Unit A Background Template Layout Sheet* and sub-cut (4) pieces from each strip to match the same width of the Template Layout Sheet. (Total=(8) pieces)
