Accent Fabric A2

Step 4: Cut (4) 2-1/2" by 42" strips, from accent Fabric A2.



Step 5: Open and stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. The *STB Unit A Accent Template A-2 Layout Sheet* found in Bag #1 is used to cut (16) parallelograms.



Step 6: Stack and clip (8) fabric pieces under each template sheet.

Step 7: Complete the cutting on each Cut Line and place the pieces in Bag #1.

Background Fabric A3

Step 8: Cut **(3)** 7-1/2" by 42" strips and **(2)** 6-1/4" by 42" strips from Background Fabric A3.

Step 9: Open and stack the strips facing *right-side-up.* Place each size into its own pile. Cut the following pieces from each strip set. The templates are found in Bag #1.

- 7-1/2" strips, cut (16) pieces STB T-Template A-2L.
- 7-1/2" strips, cut (16) pieces STB T-Template A-2R.
- 6-1/4" strips, cut (16) pieces STB T-Template A-1L.
- 6-1/4" strips, cut (16) pieces STB T-Template A-1R.



Step 10: Place the template pieces back into Bag #1.

FOUNDATION SHEETS B1, B2, B3 & B4, BAG 2

Cutting Strips for Unit B:

The cut size for each strip is 2" by 42".

- **1.** Fabric #B1: Cut (8) 2" by 42" Strips.
- **2.** Fabric #B2: Cut (12) 2" by 42" Strips.
- **3.** Fabric #B3: Cut (6) 2" by 42" Strips.

Cutting Strips Sets: After the strips are stacked, position two *STB Strip Piecing Templates* onto the top layer of each strip set. Make **(2)** cuts, the same size and shape of the Strip Piecing Template from each strip.



Sort the Sub-Strips: Place the sub-strips in the color order listed below, then clip them to the respective Foundation Sheets.

- **1.** Foundation Sheets B1: (4) each of Fabrics B2 & B1. Stack the strips with the B2 strips on the bottom and the B1 on top.
- **2.** Foundation Sheets B2: (4) each of Fabrics B3, B2, & B1. Stack the strips beginning with B3 on the bottom, ending with B1 on the top.
- **3.** Foundation Sheets B3: (4) each of Fabrics B2, B3, B2, & B1. Stack the strips with B2 on the bottom, then B3, then B2, ending with B1 on the top.
- **4.** Foundation Sheets B4: (4) each of Fabrics B1, B2, B3, B2. Stack the strips beginning with B1 on the bottom, then B2, Then B3, ending with B2 on top.

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Accent Fabric C2

NOTE - There are two cutting options for Unit C, Fabric C2.

Option One: Yellow & Blue Quilt: Cut **(11)** 4-1/4" by 42" strips from Accent Fabric C2.

Option Two: Pink & Teal Quilt: Cut **(16)** 4-1/4" by 42" strips from Accent Fabric C2.



Step 1: Open and stack the strips facing *right-side-up* into two stacks. The *STB Unit C Accent Template Layout Sheet* in Bag #3 is used to cut (3) parallelograms from each strip. Re-stack the parallelograms into (4) equal stacks. (Option 1: (8) pieces in stack, (Option Two: (12) pieces in each stack) Clip the pieces together on each Sec. # between the cut lines along the edge of the template before completing the cutting. Place these pieces back into Bag #3.



Background Fabric C3

NOTE - There are two cutting options for Unit C, Fabric C3.

Option One: Yellow & Blue Quilt:

- Cut (2) 2-1/2" by 42" strips from Accent Fabric C3.
- Cut (4) 5-1/2" by 42" strips from Accent Fabric C3.



Step 1: Cut (4) pieces with *Template C1* and (8) pieces with *Template C2*. Place these pieces in Bag #3.
