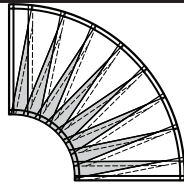

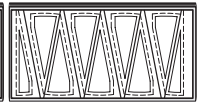

Background Fabric B1:a Unit B (TLS)	2-1/8 yds (76-1/2")	Dark Blue:a
Background Fabric B1:b Unit B (TLS)	1/2 yd (18")	Medium Dark Blue:b
Background Fabric B1:c Unit B (TLS)	1/2 yd (18")	Medium Blue:c
Accent Fabric B2:a Unit B (B Spike Temp)	1-1/4 yd (45")	Pale Green:a
Accent Fabric B2:b Unit B (B Spike Temp)	7/8 yd (31-1/2")	Cream:b
Background Fabric B3:a (T-Template B)	1-3/8 yds (49-1/2")	Dark Blue:a
Background Fabric B3:b (T-Template C, F & G)	1 yds (36")	Medium Dark Blue:b
Background Fabric B3:c (T-Template D & E)	1/4 yds (9")	Medium Blue:c

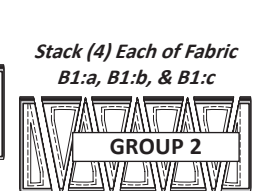
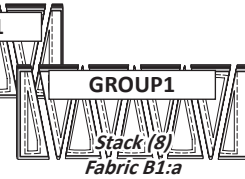


Set the remaining fabric aside.

▶ Sorting & Stacking the B1:a-c Fabrics

- **GROUP 1:** Re-stack (16) of the rectangles cut from Fabric B1:a into two stacks of (8) pieces.
- **GROUP 2:** Place the remaining (4) rectangles cut from each Fabric B1:a, B1:b and B1:c into one stack of (12) pieces.

Step 3: Place (1) *INW Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet* onto each stack of fabric. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric pieces together with the template pieces. Complete the cutting on each Cut Line and place the pieces from Group 1 in sub-bag #2-1 and the pieces from group 2 in Sub-bag #2-2.

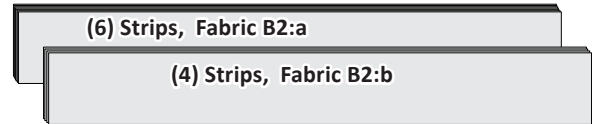


Stack (4) Each of Fabric B1:a, B1:b, & B1:c

▶ Accent Fabrics B2:a-b

Step 4: A total of (10) 7-1/4" by 42" strips are cut from the B2:a-b Fabrics.

- Cut (6) Strips from Fabric B2:a
- Cut (4) Strips from Fabric B2:b

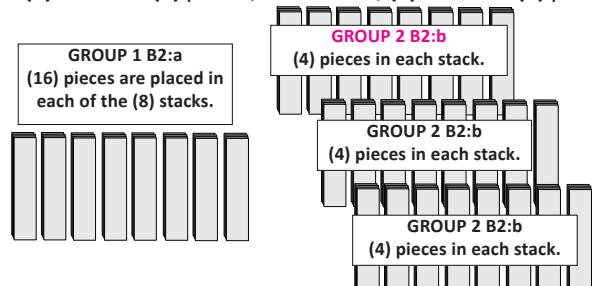


Step 5: Open and stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. The *INW Unit B Accent B Spike Template* in Bag #2 is used to cut (224) 1-3/4" by 7-1/4" pieces. (128) pieces are cut from Fabric B2:a and (96) pieces are cut from Fabric B2:b.

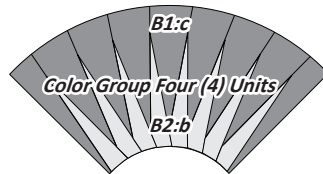
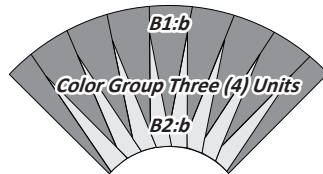
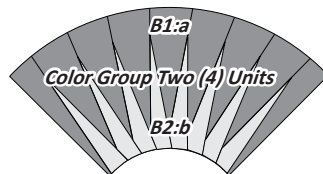
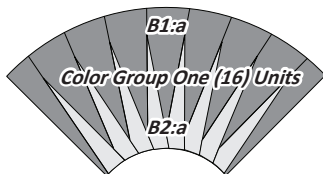


▶ Sorting & Stacking the B2:a-b Fabrics

- **GROUP 1:** Fabric B2:a, (8) stacks of (16) pieces.
- **GROUP 2:** The remaining fabric are counted and placed into three stacks. Fabric B2:b, (8) stacks of (4) pieces, Fabric B2:b, (8) stacks of (4) pieces, Fabric B2:b, (8) stacks of (4) pieces.



Paper clips are used to keep the fabric pieces together in each group. Place Group 1 into Sub-bag #2-1 and Group 2 into Sub-bag #2-2. You may want to further separate Group 2 into 3 Sub-bags, #2-2a-#2-2c.



▶ Background Fabric B1:a, b, & c

Step 1: (14) 7-1/2" by 42" strips are cut from the B1 Fabrics a, b, & c.

- Cut (10) Strips from Fabric B1:a
- Cut (2) Strips from Fabric B1:b
- Cut (2) Strips from Fabric B1:c



Step 2: Open and stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. The *INW Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet* in Bag #2 is used to cut a total of (28) 7-1/2" by 16" rectangles. (20) rectangles are cut from Fabric B1:a, and (4) are cut from each Fabric B1:b and B1:c.
