## Sorting \& Stacking the C1:a-b Fabrics

Step 3: The parallelograms are counted and sorted into three different groups:

1. GROUP 1: Stack (32) of the pieces cut from Fabric C1:a, into (4) stacks of (8) pieces. Label these stacks as GROUP 1.
2. GROUP 2: Stack (16) of the pieces cut from Fabric C1:a into (2) stacks of (8) pieces. Label these stacks as GROUP 2.
3. GROUP 3: Stack the (16) pieces cut from Fabric C1:b into (2) stacks of (8) pieces. Label these stacks as GROUP 3.
Step 4: Place (1) Unit C Background Template Layout Sheet on each fabric stack. Clip the templates to the fabric pieces and complete the cutting. Place the pieces in each group into their own sub-bags labeled Group 1, Group 2, and Group 3.


## - Accent Fabric C2:a-b

Step 5: Cut (32) 4-1/4" by 42" strips from Accent Fabrics C2:a-b.

- Cut (16) Strips from Fabric C2:a
- Cut (16) Strips from Fabric C2:b


Step 6: Open and stack the strips facing right-side-up. The INW Unit C Accent Template Layout Sheets in Bag \#3 are used to cut the strips. Discard the leftover fabric.


Step 7: The strips are cut and paired up with the three previous groups. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric pieces with the templates after they are cut.

1. GROUP 1: Stack the (16) rectangles cut from Fabric C2:a into (2) stacks of (8) pieces. Complete the cutting, and place in the bag labelled GROUP 1.

2. GROUP 2: Stack (8) pieces cut from Fabric C2:b into (1) stack. Complete the cutting and place in the bag labelled GROUP 2.

3. GROUP 3: Stack (8) pieces cut from Fabric C2:b into (1) stack. Complete the cutting and place in the bag labelled GROUP 3.


## Background Fabric C3:a-b

Step 8: A total of (8) 2-1/2" by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips are cut from Fabrics C3:a-b.

- Cut (6) Strips from Fabric C3:a
- Cut (2) Strips from Fabric C3:b


Step 9: Open and stack the strips facing right-side-up. The INW T-Template $\boldsymbol{A}$ in Bag \#3 is used to cut (12) pieces from Fabric C3:a and (4) pieces from Fabric C3:b. Each piece should measure 2-1/2" by $20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

1. GROUP 1: Fabric C3:a: place (8) pieces in the bag labelled GROUP 1.
2. GROUP 2: Fabric C3:a: place (4) pieces in the bag labelled GROUP 2.
3. GROUP 3: Fabric C3:b: place (4) pieces in the bag labelled GROUP 3.

Step 10: Place the (3) sub-bags back into Bag \#3.

Step 2: Open and stack the strips facing right-side-up. The INW Unit DL \& DR Background Template Layout Sheet in Bag \#4 is used to cut (16) pieces.
