

Fabric Width: The yardage amounts and cutting instructions were calculated to use $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide fabrics. If the fabrics are not $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide, you might want to recalculate the yardage before you begin cutting.

Cutting Errors: If cutting mistakes are made when cutting your fabrics, it may require you to purchase additional yardage. If paper supplies are needed to correct an error, please contact Quiltworx.com and we will try and help you replace what you need. You will be liable to cover the cost of replacing the paper and shipping, if required.
Fabric: Fabric swatches should be pasted onto the Templates and Layout Sheets as well the first piece of foundation paper before you cut your fabrics. It is helpful to identify the fabric position with the foundation papers. Remember, hatching on your foundation papers does not denote the use of light medium and dark fabrics. In these instructions some of our background sections are covered with light fabric, others are covered with dark fabrics.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cutting Your Fabric: Read the information printed on each Template Layout Sheet before you begin cutting your fabrics. Note the following:

1. There are Cut Lines on each Template Layout Sheet referred to as Cut Lines 1, 2, 3, and etc. The Template Layout Sheets ARE NOT sub-cut until AFTER they have been laid on top of the respective pieces of fabric.
2. When the fabrics are stacked beneath the Template Layout Sheets, only then should these lines be cut. If you cut on any other lines, you will ruin your fabric pieces.
3. The excess fabric around each template is not cut off until after the fabric pieces are sewn to the Foundation Papers. This is done with the Add-A-Quarter Ruler.
4. Large paper clips are used to hold the Template Layout Sheets onto your fabrics. Inormally place my paper clips on each section around the edge of the Template Layout Sheet before I cut the sections apart. This keeps the templates and fabrics together for each section.
5. Fabric numbers have been assigned and printed on each of the templates and Template Layout Sheets.
6. The Graphics in the cutting instructions show how many Templates or Template Layout Sheets are cut from each strip, the instructions tell you the total pieces you will need to cut. However, this does not necessarily represent how many sheets you have in your pattern. There are enough cutting templates included to layer no more than (12) pieces of fabric beneath each template before cutting.

Step 3: Stack the pieces into two stacks of (8). Place one layout sheet onto each stack of fabric. Clip the layout sheets onto the fabrics, then complete the cutting. Place the pieces in Bag \#4.


## Accent Fabric D2:a

Step 1: Cut (4) 2" by 42" strips from Fabric D2:a.

Step 2: Open and stack the strips facing right-side-up. The INW Unit DL \& DR Accent Template D2 Layout Sheet in Bag \#4 is used to cut (16) pieces.


Step 3: Stack the pieces into two stacks of (8). Place one layout sheet onto each stack of fabric. Clip the templates onto the fabrics, then complete the cutting. Place the pieces in Bag \#4.

## UNIT E, BAG 5

## - Background Fabric E1:a

Step 1: Cut (1) $10^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strip from Fabric E1:a. Position the strip facing right-side-up. The INW Unit E Background Template Layout Sheet in Bag \#5 is used to cut (4) pieces.


Step 2: Position the layout sheet onto your fabric pieces. Clip the templates onto the fabrics, then complete the cutting. Place the pieces in Bag \#5.


## Accent Fabric E2:a

Step 1: Cut (1) 7-1/4" by 42" strip from Fabric E2:a. Position the strip facing right-side-up. The INW Unit E, Accent E-Spike Template in Bag \#5 is used to cut (28) pieces. Place the pieces in Bag \#5.


## UNIT F, BAG 6

## Background Fabric E1:a

Step 1: Cut (11) 7-1/4" by 42" strips from Fabric E1:a. Stack the strips facing right-side-up. The INW Unit F Background Template Layout Sheet (see note at the bottom of the page) in Bag \#6 is used to cut (33) pieces.


Step 2: Re-stack the parallograms right-side-up into (3) stacks of (11) and position (1) TLS onto each. Complete the cutting and place the pieces in Bag \#6.


## Accent Fabric E2:a

Step 1: Cut (16) $7-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips from Fabric E2:a. Position the strip facing right-side-up making two stacks of (8) pieces. The INW Unit F Template Layout Sheet in Bag \#6 is used to complete the cutting. Place the pieces in Bag \#6.

nOTE-Unit F Background Template Layout Sheet: In the initial printing, the (2) Newsprint (NP) 231 only included (2) Unit F Background Template Layout Sheets and you need (3). A 3rd TLS was printed on an $11 \times 17$ piece of newsprint of its own labeled NP231 Extra Template. An error on the main newsprint was also corrected. Fabric \#F1 on the newsprint, was changed to the correct reference of Fabric \#E1 on the Extra Template. The original newsprint will be corrected at the next printing.
