
Rainbow Color Block Layout

Fabric Swatches should be cut, arranged and pasted onto the block layout below and before you begin cutting your fabric. Do not cover up the Fabric #s, as you will need them to refer back to once you begin cutting your fabric. If you choose to use a selection of different fabrics, you will need to assign our fabric #s to your fabric. This will help you keep organized when you begin cutting and stacking the strips and background pieces. Additional yardage information, including how to calculate your own yardage if you use a different color layout is provided on Page 3 under 'Cutting Strips' and also on Page 22 under 'Generic Clamshell Yardage'. It is pretty simple to calculate the yardage so don't be afraid to take a little time and do your own thing! You can also use Quiltster!
