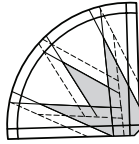


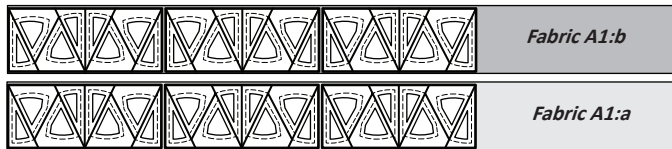
## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAG #1, UNIT A1

**Graphics:** The graphics shown for each template in the cutting instructions were included to demonstrate how to position the templates on your fabric. Remember to stack and layer the fabrics before cutting. This will reduce your cutting time.

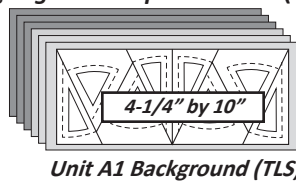
### ► Unit A1 Background (TLS) (Fabric A1:a & A1:b)



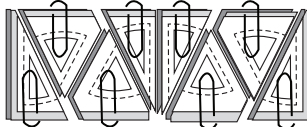
**Step 1:** Cut (1) 4-1/4" by 42" strip from each Fabric A1:a & A1:b. Subcut each strip into (3) 4-1/4" by 10" rectangles.



**Step 2:** Stack the rectangles facing *right-side-up*. Place the (3) pieces cut from Fabric A1:b on the bottom and the (3) pieces cut from Fabric A1:a on the top. Position the Background Unit A1 (TLS) on top your stack.

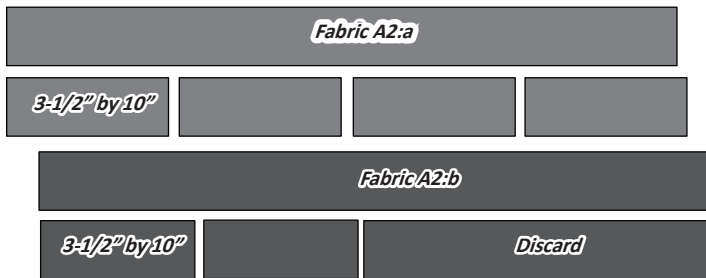


**Step 3:** Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-7, in order. Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section and place back into Bag #1.

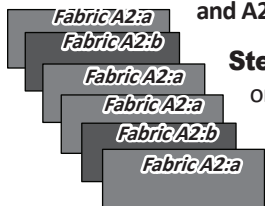


### ► Unit A1 Accent Spikes (Fabric A2:a & A2:b)

**Step 4:** Cut (1) 3-1/2" by 42" strip from each Fabric A2:a & A2:b. Subcut Fabric A2:a into (4) 3-1/2" by 10" rectangles. Subcut Fabric A2:b into (2) 3-1/2" by 10" rectangles. Discard the remaining fabric.



**Step 5:** Stack the rectangles facing *right-side-up* in the order shown. Starting with Fabric A2:a on the bottom then A2:b, A2:a, A2:a, A2:b, and A2:a on the top.



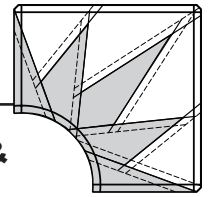
**Step 6:** Position the Unit A1 Spike Template onto the top of your stack.

**Step 7:** Using the Spike template provided, subcut (6) 1-1/2" by 3-1/2" strip sets.



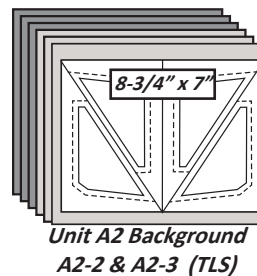
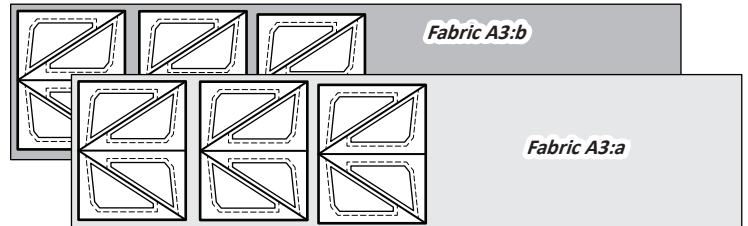
**Step 8:** Stack and clip the strip sets together into (3) groups. Do not change the stacking order. Place these pieces into Bag #1 with the Unit A1 Background pieces.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAG #2, UNIT A2, COLOR OPTION 1



### ► Background (TLS) (Fabric A3:a & A3:b)

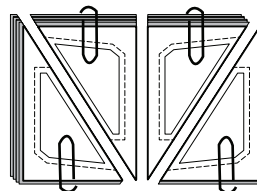
**Step 1:** Cut (1) 8-3/4" by 42" strip from each Fabric A3:a & A3:b. Subcut each strip into (3) 8-3/4" by 7" rectangles. Discard the remaining fabric. (See the following note for a correction to Template).



**NOTE - Unit A2 Background TLS (A2-2 & A2-3):** If you haven't already done so, change the 7" x 42" Strip to 8-3/4" x 42" Strip on the TLS. This allows for directional fabrics to be used for the background

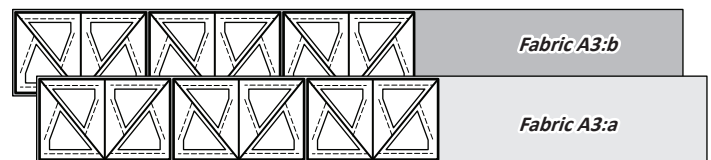
**Step 2:** Stack the rectangles facing *right-side-up*. Place the (3) pieces cut from Fabric A3:b on the bottom and the (3) pieces cut from Fabric A3:a on the top. Position the Unit A2 Background Template A2-2 & A2-3 Layout Sheet on top your stack.

**Step 3:** Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-3 to separate the templates.

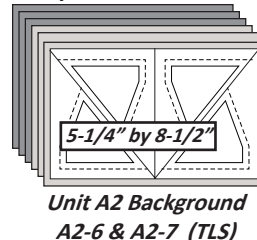


**Step 4:** Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section and place into Bag #2.

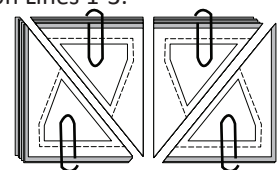
**Step 5:** Cut (1) 5-1/4" by 42" strip from each Fabric A3:a & A3:b. Subcut each strip into (3) 5-1/4" by 8-1/2" rectangles. Discard the remaining fabric.



**Step 6:** Stack the rectangles facing *right-side-up*. Place the (3) pieces cut from Fabric A3:b on the bottom and the (3) pieces cut from Fabric A3:a on the top. Position the Unit A2 Background Template A2-6 & A2-7 Layout Sheet on top your stack.



**Step 7:** Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-3.



**Step 8:** Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section and place into Bag #2.
