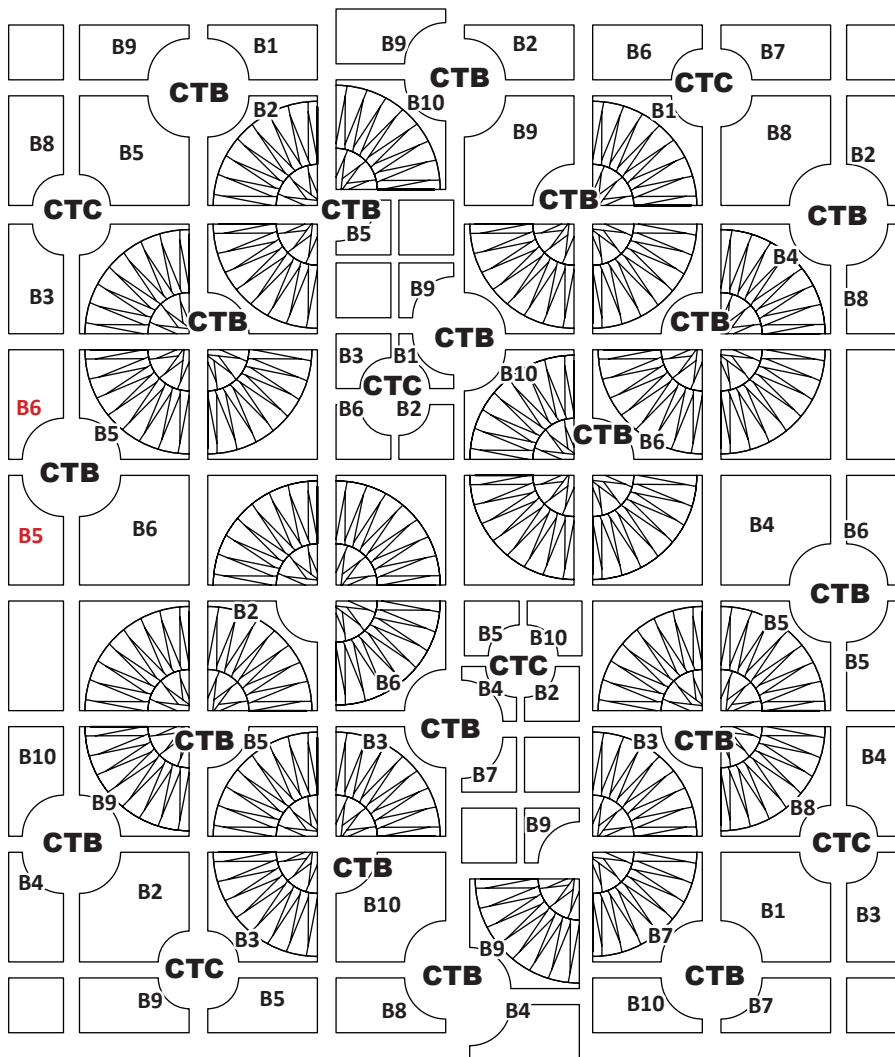

CUTOUT TEMPLATE DIAGRAM

► T-Template A Cutout Template Cutting

1. Cut **(12)** T-Temp A pieces with Cutout Temp B.
2. Cut **(4)** T-Temp A pieces with Cutout Temp C.

► T-Template B Cutout Template Cutting

1. Cut **(4)** T-Temp B pieces with Cutout Temp. B on **(2)** opposite Corners
2. Cut **(2)** T-Temp B pieces with Cutout Temp. B on **(1)** Corner
3. Cut **(2)** T-Temp. B with **(1)** Cutout Temp B on one corner and **(1)** Cutout Temp C on the opposite Corner.

► T-Template C Cutout Template Cutting

1. Cut **(16)** Cutout Temp. B from T-Template C
2. Cut **(8)** Cutout Temp. C from T-Template C

► T-Template D Cutout Template Cutting

1. Cut **(4)** T-Temp D with Cutout Temp B in one corner.
2. Cut **(6)** T-Temp D with Cutout Temp C in one corner.
3. Cut **(2)** T-Temp D with Cutout Temp B in one corner and Cutout Temp C in the opposite corner.

CREATING YOUR OWN COLORWAY

If you have your heart set on figuring out how to create your own color approach to this pattern, the following will help you do so in a way that will help you conserve yardage while still achieving the look you want.

► Unit A

- **(1)** 9" Strip provides enough background fabric for **(3)** Unit A
- **(1)** 7-3/4" Strip provides enough accent fabric for **(4)** Unit A

► Unit B

- **(1)** 5" Strip provides enough background fabric for **(6)** Unit B
- **(1)** 5-1/4" Strip provides enough accent fabric for **(10)** Unit B

► Unit C

- **(1)** 4-1/2" Strip provides enough background fabric for **(7)** Unit C
- **(1)** 4-1/2" Strip provides enough accent fabric for **(12)** Unit C

► T-Template A

- The number of T-Template A pieces you need is determined based on how many Unit A pieces you make. You will need one T-Template A for each Unit A you make.
- **(1)** 10-1/2" strip yields **(4)** T-Template A pieces.

► T-Template B

- The number of T-Template B pieces you need is determined by the amount of open space you would like in your quilt.
- **(1)** 10-1/2" strip yields **(4)** T-Template B1 pieces.

► T-Template C

- The number of T-Template C pieces you need is always going to be **(26)** for the size quilt on the coversheet.
- **(1)** 10-1/2" strip yields **(8)** T-Template C pieces.

► T-Template D

- The number of T-Template D pieces you need is always going to be **(4)** for the corners, then, **(4)** times the number of **(4)** patch blocks you might choose to put inside your quilt. For the cover quilt layout, this was **(16)**.
- **(1)** 11" strip yields **(12)** T-Template B1 pieces.
