

Temp G-4 Correction ~ Dragon Star Pattern

In the original pattern, we forgot to mention the Temp G-4 Option. This is not required and we sometimes use it and sometimes we don't. It depends on the color of fabric chosen for the Tip of the Star versus the color chosen for the Geese. If we want to have some contrast, we add a small background piece for Template G-4 (which shows up on your papers). However, you don't have to sew this piece in. You can simply start with the G-1 Geese Template and sew that over the top of both Sec. 1 and 2 on Unit C1R. If you want to ADD, Template G-4, please use the following templates. They will be cut out of the leftover rectangles from Fabric C1. The Templates provided here are the correct size for you to cut out and use this extra piece. Add Step 4 to your Fabric C1 cutting directions on Page 19. We will add the Template to the papers in future printings and also add the instructions you see here as appropriate.

Step 4: You will have several left over rectangles from Fabric C1. Use the Temp. G-4 template to cut (4) rectangles for Unit C1R, Sec. 1, if desired. This allows you to add a contrasting fabric to Unit C1R on the edge to achieve contrast. If you do not want to use this, you can just ignore this piece and use the G-1 goose over both sections. It is up to you.
