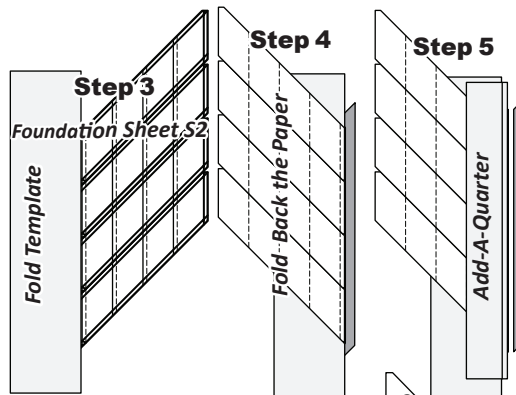


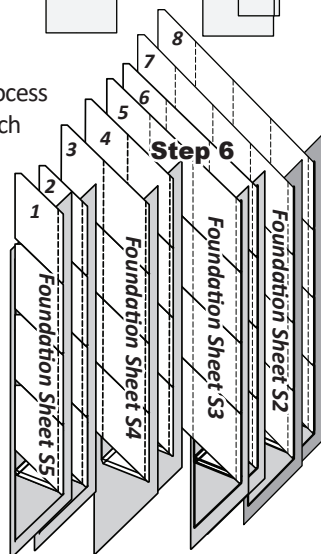
Step 3: Start with **Foundation Sheet S2**, place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1, lining the edge up on the solid black line marked Line 1.

Step 4: Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template.

Step 5: Place the **Add-A-Quarter** ruler next to the folded back paper lip-side down and trim the fabric with your rotary cutter. This leaves you with a quarter-inch seam allowance which, is lined up with the next strip of fabric.



Step 6: Repeat the trimming process in the previous Steps 3-5 on each **Foundation Sheet S5, S4, S3, and S2**. Stack the papers as you trim starting with Paper #8 on the bottom, ending with Paper #1 on the top as shown on the right.



► Round 2: Strips 1-10

Strips 1-8: Round 2 strips 1-8 are positioned under the Sec. 2 diamond on each **Foundation Sheet** labeled S2-S5.

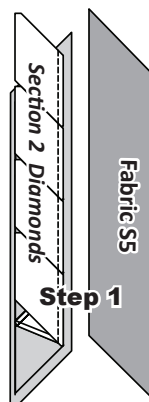
Strips 9-10: Round 2 strips 9-10 are placed wrong-side-up under the Sec. 1 Diamonds on the backside of both **Foundation Sheets S1**. These strips are not sewn until Round 3.

1. Pair Fabric S5, Strip #1, to Foundation Sheet S5, Sec 2.
2. Pair Fabric S5, Strip #2 to Foundation Sheet S5, Sec 2.
3. Pair Fabric S6, Strip #3 to Foundation Sheet S4, Sec 2.
4. Pair Fabric S6, Strip #4 to Foundation Sheet S4, Sec 2.
5. Pair Fabric S7, Strip #5 to Foundation Sheet S3, Sec 2.
6. Pair Fabric S7, Strip #6 to Foundation Sheet S3, Sec 2.
7. Pair Fabric S8, Strip #7 to Foundation Sheet S2, Sec 2.
8. Pair Fabric S8, Strip #8 to Foundation Sheet S2, Sec 2.
9. Pair Fabric S9 Strip #9 to Foundation Sheet S1, Sec 1.
10. Pair Fabric S10 Strip #10 to Foundation Sheet S1, Sec 1.

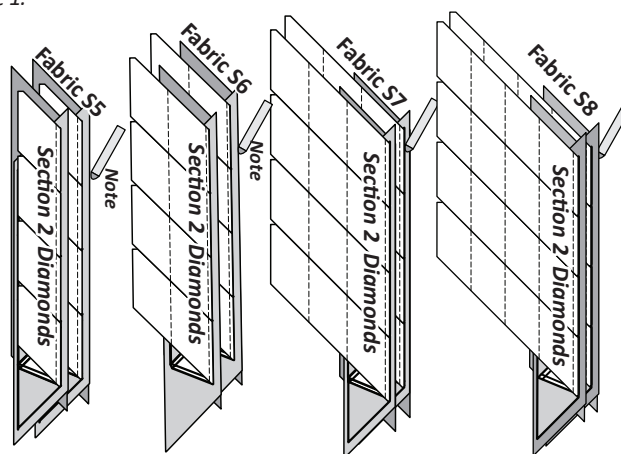
Step 1: Position Strip #1, Round 2 [Fabric S5] **right-side-up** on your table along the edge of **Foundation Sheet S5**. Lift the foundation paper and slide the strip under the **Section 2 Diamonds**. Line the raw edges along the trimmed sew-side.

Step 2: Repeat **Step 1** for each of the **Foundation Sheets** labeled S5, S4, S3, & S2.

NOTE - Glue Helps!: A small amount of glue added along the raw edges of each fabric strip will keep the edges secure as

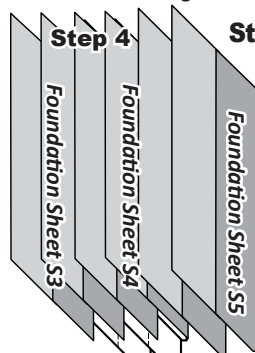


you feed the fabric between the presser foot and feed dogs when sewing on Line 1.



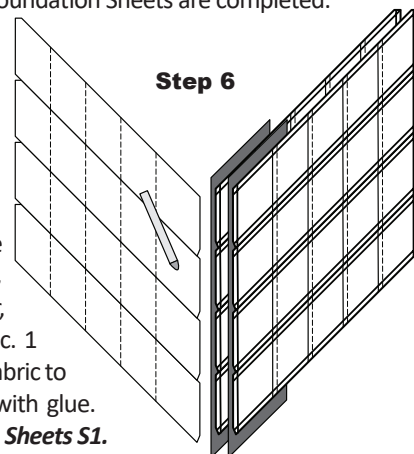
Step 3: Open the papers and sew on Line 1. The stitches should start and stop about 1/8" before the beginning and end of Line 1.

NOTE - Glue Management: Loosen the glue under Sec. 1 before you press.



Step 4: Flip the papers over and press the fabric to the open position on the backside of each Foundation Sheet S5, S4, S3, and S2.

Step 5: Foundation Sheet S5 is now complete. Set these aside until all remaining Foundation Sheets are completed.



Step 6: Place Strip #9 [Fabric S9] **wrong-side-up** on your table along the edge of **Foundation Sheet S1**. Lift the foundation paper, slide the strip under the Sec. 1 diamonds and adhere the fabric to the backside of the paper with glue. Repeat for both **Foundation Sheets S1**.

Step 7: The sewing will continue for Foundation Sheets S1, S2, S3, & S4 in **Round 3**. To prepare for Round 3, stack and trim the Foundation Sheets described in the following steps.

Step 8: Stack the papers as shown with Paper #3 on the bottom, ending with Paper #10 on the top.

Step 9: Starting with **Foundation Sheet S1**, place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1, lining the edge up with Line 1. Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template and trim a quarter-inch seam with the **Add-A-Quarter** ruler.
