

GROUP A: GENERAL INFORMATION FOUNDATION PAPERS AND TEMPLATES

► (2) NP 482

Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (4) bags to complete the organization for these instructions. Label the bags (#A1 to #A4) to stay organized while cutting the Foundation Units and Templates.

- Bag #A1: (2) of ea. Foundation Sheets S1 to S5, **SS Templates**
- Bag #A2: (8) Unit A2 Papers and Cutting Templates
- Bag #A3: (8) Unit A3 Papers and Cutting Templates
- Bag #A4: (1) of each T-Templates A-1 and A-8

► Preparing the Foundation Papers:

Foundation Papers: This booklet includes enough foundation papers to complete (1) 62" diameter center. The foundation papers and templates for this pattern are printed on newsprint. Newsprint is lightweight and tears away from your stitches without damaging the threads. Please pull apart this package and check, at this time, to make sure your pattern includes all of the newsprint shown below and to the right.

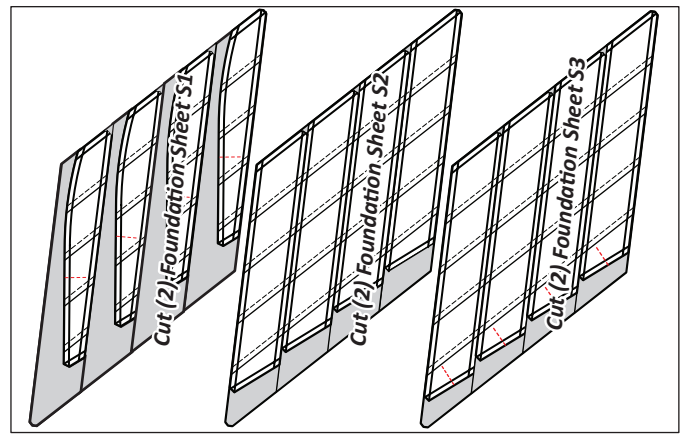
Step 1: Cut out (2) of each Foundation Sheet S1 to S5 [NP 482 and NP 483], (8) of each Unit A2 and A3 [NP 484], and (1) of each T-Template, (4) **SS Templates**, and the Template Layout Sheets on [TP 298, NP 483, and NP 484]. See the newsprint graphics to the right for information on how to organize your units and templates into bags. *Refer back to *General Information Booklet for Foundation papers and templates* for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.

NOTE - Interior Foundation Paper (Part 2) Cut Lines on the Foundation Sheets: Each foundation sheet includes (4) rows of diamonds. The rows are not cut apart until after the paper piecing is completed. The lines are labeled as Part 2 to designate not cutting these apart at this time.

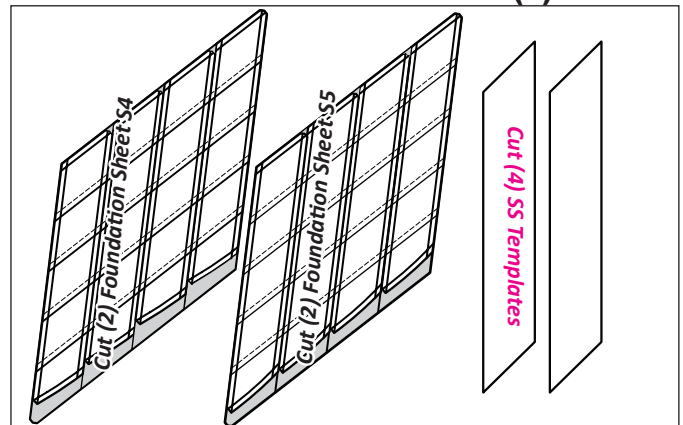
► Flower Petal Center Fabric Information:

The table at the top of Page 6 includes yardage, fabric references, and which fabrics should go with which cutting templates to complete Group A (not including the Lone Star. Reference Page 10 for the Lone Star). Use the table as a guide for staying organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the Assigned Colors column!

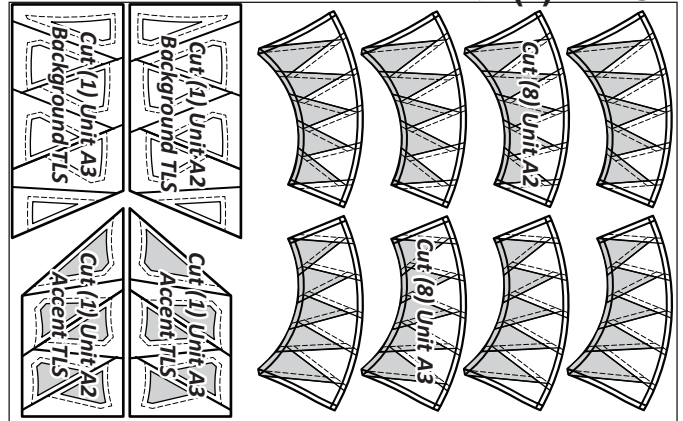
