
Step 3: With the TLS already in place, slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart.




Step 4: Clip each stack together and place them in the following Bags:

- (1) Stack of Template B3-5 Sec. 5 into Bag #B3.
- (5) Template B2-5 Sec. 5 Stacks into Bag #B2.
- (1) Stack of Template B1-4 Sec. 4 into Bag #B1.
- (1) Stack of Template B1-5 Sec. 5 into Bag #B1.


► Fabric B2

Step 1: From Fabric B2, cut **(8)** 4" x 42" strips.



Step 2: Stack these *right-side-up* into (1) stack and use the *Unit B1, B2, B3, & B4 Background #2 Sheets 1 and 2 Template Layout Sheets* to sub-cut (2) stacks of rectangles the size of the two sheets.

Step 3: With the TLS already in place, slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart.



Step 4: Clip each stack together and place in the following Bags:

- (1) Stack of Template B4-2 Sec. 2 into Bag #B4
- (1) Stack of Template B3-1 Sec. 1 into Bag #B3
- (1) Stack of Template B3-3 Sec. 3 into Bag #B3
- (5) Template B2-1 Sec. 1 into Bag #B2
- (5) Template B2-3 Sec. 3 into Bag #B2
- (1) Stack of Template B1-1 Sec. 1 into Bag #B1


► Fabric B3

Step 1: From Fabric B3, cut **(4)** 4" x 42" strips.



Step 2: Stack these *right-side-up* into (1) stack and use the *Unit B1, B2, B3, & B4 Accent #1 TLS* to sub-cut (2) stacks of rectangles the size of the Template Layout Sheet. You will have to re-position your TLS to cut the second stack.

Step 3: Re-stack the strips into one stack of (8). Then, place the *Unit B1*, *B2*, *B3 Accent #2 TLS* on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart.




Step 4: Clip each stack together and place them in the following Bags:

- (1) Stack of Template B3-4 Sec. 4 into Bag #B3.
- (1) Stack of Template B1-3 Sec. 3 into Bag #B1.
- (5) Stacks of Template B2-4 Sec. 4 into Bag #B2.


► Fabric B4

Step 1: From Fabric B4, cut **(4)** 4-1/4" x 42" strips.



Step 2: Stack these *right-side-up* into (1) stack and use the *Unit B1, B2, B3 & B4 Accent #2 TLS* to sub-cut (2) stacks of fabric pieces the same size of the Template Layout Sheet. You will have to re-position your TLS to cut the second stack.

Step 3: Re-stack the strips into one stack of **(8)**. Then, place the *Unit B1*, *B2*, *B3*, & *B4 Accent #2 TLS* on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart.



Step 4: Clip each stack together and place them in the following Bags:

- (1) Stack of Template B4-1 Sec. 1 into Bag #B4.
- (1) Stack of Template B3-2 Sec. 2 into Bag #B3.
- (1) Stack of Template B1-2 Sec. 2 into Bag #B1.
- (5) Stacks of Template B2-2 Sec. 2 into Bag #B2.

SORTING AND STACKING UNITS B1 TO B4: BAGS #B1 TO #B4

Complete the sorting and paper piecing, one Bag at a time. The graphics for stacking all **(4)** Bags, however, are shown below. Sort the pieces in Bag #B1 on your table with the templates and fabric pieces facing *right-side-up*. The stacking begins with Template B1-5 for Sec. 5 on the bottom. The sew sides are aligned at the top. The pieces are then stacked in reverse order, finishing with Template B1-1 for Sec. 1 on top. Complete the same steps when you are ready to begin working on Bag #B2, #B3, and #B4. Bag B4 only has **(2)** sections in it. Note that Bag #B2 has Units B2-1 to B2-5. It is not necessary to create special stacking for each B2 unit. The stacking is the same for all of them. Stacking graphics for each unit are shown at the top of the next page.
