FRACTURED PAINT BOX ~ TP 364 Correction on Unit FPB Accent TLS1, TLS2, and TLS3.

Applies to all Patterns with a Print Date from 5/15/17 to 11/3/17.

Since June 1st of 2017, we have sold 720 of the following patterns. They will have the coversheet shown. We added TP 364 to this printing (prior to this, we did not have a TLS for the Accent Sashing so if your coversheet does not look like the following, this correction does not apply).

CORRECTION: The angles on TLS1 and TLS2 are backwards. TLS3 cuts into a rectangle, so although the angle is not shown correctly on the TLS, it will not impact your cut. Section 10 will be just fine! The TP 364 Graphic below shows the angles you SHOULD have.

The correction for the other sections is SIMPLE if you have not cut your fabrics.

Please cut your fabrics WRONG-SIDE-UP. Then, flip them over, RIGHT-SIDE-UP before you piece.

If you have already cut these pieces and cannot get them to fit, do the following:

If you purchased a kit using the Tonga Batik Espresso, just flip the pieces over and move on. It's the same front and back!

If you are using something else, you can do the following: Section 10 is Correct, so this piece can be used. The others technically fit, but are right up to your seam allowance so if use them, you may be short. Try it, and if you can't make it work on one block, then we recommend using the Sec. 4 piece for Section 2, the Section 6 piece for Section 4, and the Section 8 piece for Section 6. Ignore the angles. You will still be missing the Section 8 piece. **You will need an extra 1/2 Yard of Fabric.** You can then cut (**12**) 1-1/4° x 42° strips. Stack these and subcut them into (**4**) 1-1/4° x 10-1/2° rectangles.
