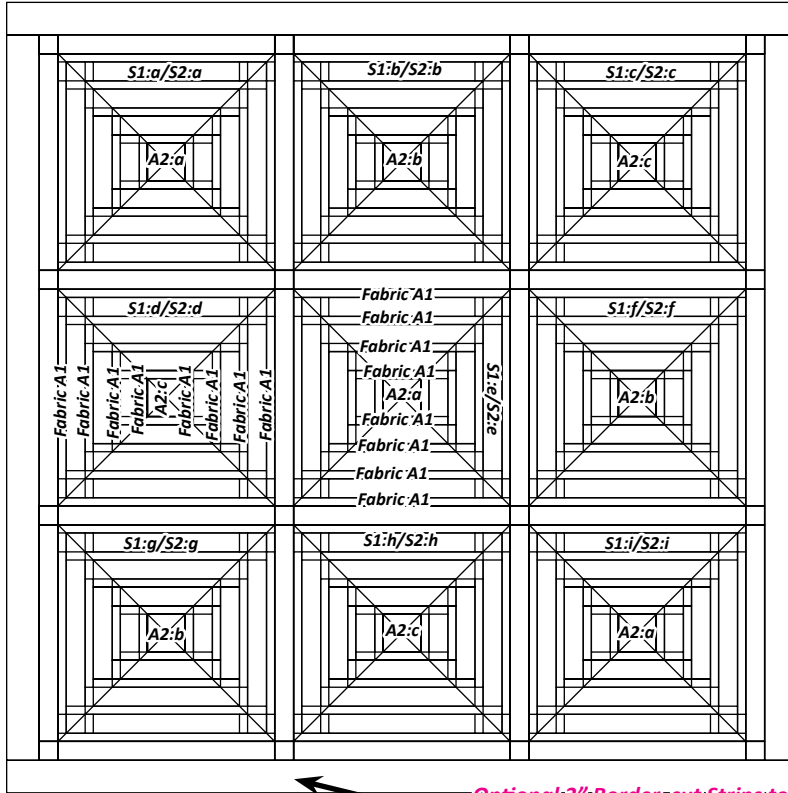


QUILTING DESIGNS AND BINDING

Quiltworx.com used a simple geometrical design with lots of circles in it to accentuate the fabric prints and blocks for the quilt. Due to the repeat of the design, we recommend this type of quilting and therefore, we have not designed a digitized quilting design for this quilt. We recommend Hobbs 80/20 batting or similar to get a nice, thin, but flexible finish to the quilt.

DOUBLE FOLDED BINDING

After the quilt top has been quilted, you can add the binding. Quiltworx.com recommends (9) 2-1/2" strips sewn end to end at a 45 degree angle, then ironed in half, lengthwise and sewn to the front of the quilt. The folded edge is hand stitched down to the back-side of the quilt.

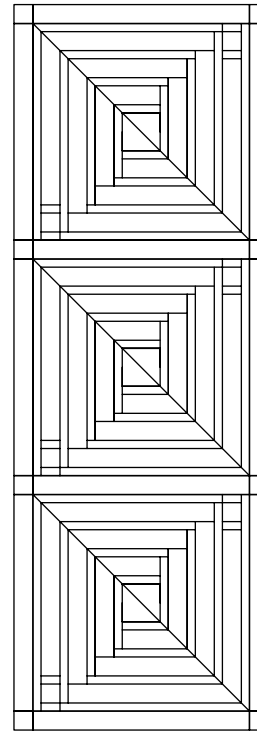
ALTERNATIVE LAYOUTS
