

FLOWER BASKET APPLIQUE AND EMBROIDERY PATTERN CORRECTION

On August 21st, 2018, it was brought to our attention that the Center Applique Layout included in the English Garden pattern did not match the Applique Embroidery file from Fabric Confetti, nor did it match the coversheet of the English Garden design. Quiltworx reviewed the files and the applique file and cover quilt included a Tulip and a Daffodil, whereas the English Garden pattern instructions (and the Poinsettia Bouquet Pattern) include 2 Daffodils. The (2) Daffodils is the correct configuration. Please see the graphic below. We have updated the applique file as of 8/21/18, but in the meantime, there are some really simple fixes for this issue!

SITUATION 1: I have the English Garden, and applique file printed before September 1, and the center layout has a tulip. I am missing (4) Stitch-N-Peel tulips in my pattern.

SOLUTION 1: Please simply use one of our sets of tulip pieces cut from Stitch-N-Peel again. Just peel it off your fabric with fusible on it, and cut a second set of pieces. Since the Stitch-N-Peel does not stay in the quilt using the digitized embroidery design, you can easily reuse the pieces and cut the missing Tulips. If you do not have the Stitch-N-Peel shapes any longer, your digitized Embroidery design includes the shapes on a printable sheet. You can simply print these out, and trace them onto your fusible to get the extra Tulips.

SITUATION 2: I have the Poinsettia Bouquet Pattern, which has the applique layout on the coversheet with (2) daffodils, but I bought the digitized embroidery design, which has a Tulip and a daffodil.

SOLUTION 2: You can either replace the Daffodil shown below on your quilt with a Tulip using the process in Solution 1, or, you can contact Quiltworx.com or Fabric Confetti and we will help you get an updated digitized embroidery file that has (2) daffodils.

SITUATION 3: I have the English Garden pattern. I am not using the Embroidery Design, but I really wanted the tulip, not the daffodil.

SOLUTION 3: Please consider replacing the Tulip with a Daffodil instead! This is how we intended the pattern to be! Or, contact Quiltworx.com and we can send out an applique packet with 4 additional tulips.

The flower shown here should be a Daffodil, not a Tulip
