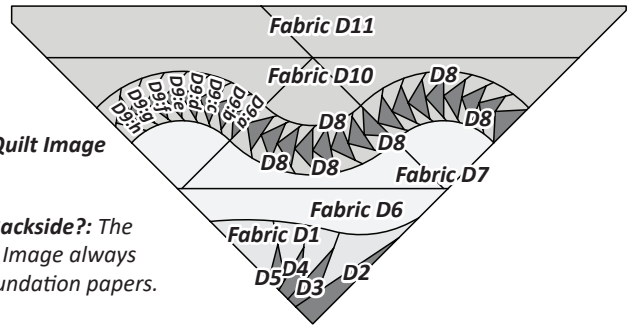


Backside Quilt Image



NOTE - Why Backside?: The Backside Quilt Image always matches your foundation papers.

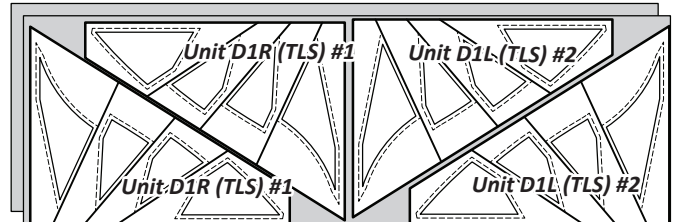
► **Color Layout**

| Fabric D2: Unit D1L, D1R Temp D1L-8 & D1R-8 | 1/4 yd or (6") | Fabric Swatch |
| Fabric D3: Unit D1L, D1R Temp D1L-6 & D1R-6 | 1/4 yd or (3-1/2") | Fabric Swatch |
| Fabric D4: Unit D1L, D1R Temp D1L-4 & D1R-4 | 1/4 yd or (3") | Fabric Swatch |
| Fabric D5: Unit D1L, D1R Temp D1L-2 & D1R-2 | 1/8 yd or (2-1/2") | Fabric Swatch |
| Fabric D6: T-Temp D-1, D-2 | 1/2 yd or (18") | Fabric Swatch |
| Fabric D7: T-Temp D-3, D-4 | 1-1/8 yds or 39-1/2" | Fabric Swatch |

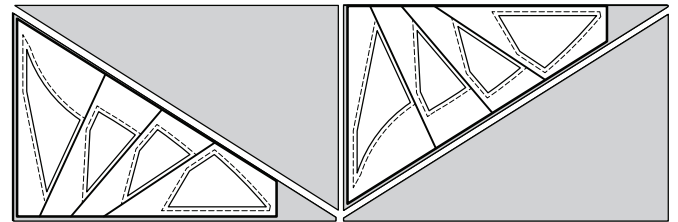
■ **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: UNIT D1R & D1L**

► **Fabric D1: (TLS) #1 & (TLS) #2**

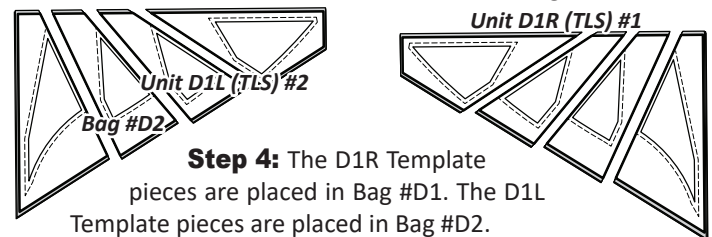
Step 1: Cut and stack (2) 13-1/2" by 42" strips facing *right-side up*.



Step 2: Unit D1R, Template Layout Sheet #1 and Unit D1L Template Layout Sheet #2 are used to cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of each (TLS). Template Layout Sheet #1 is used to cut the first four pieces. Template Layout Sheet #2 is used to cut the last four pieces. We have provided you with only one template so you will need to reposition the template for each cut.



Step 3: Paper clip are used to clip each section to the fabric to keep the template pieces from moving in the cutting process. The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper and fabric on each CUT LINE to separate the individual pieces. **Bag #D1**



Step 4: The D1R Template pieces are placed in Bag #D1. The D1L Template pieces are placed in Bag #D2.

► **Fabric D2: Temp D1L-8 & D1R-8**

Step 5: Cut and stack (2) 3" by 42" strip facing *right-side up*.

Step 6: The Unit D1L & D1R Templates D1L-8 & D1R-8 are placed onto the strip. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of each template.



Step 7: The cutting is completed by cutting around the D1R-8 template, repositioning it, then using the D1L-8 template to cut (4) of each.



Step 8: Templates D1R-8 are placed in Bag #D1 and Templates D1L-8 are placed in Bag #D2.

► **Fabric D3: Temp D1L-6 & D1R-6**

Step 9: Cut and stack (1) 3-1/2" by 42" strip facing *right-side up*.

Step 10: The *Unit D1L & D1R Templates D1L-6 & D1R-6* are placed onto the strip. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of each template.



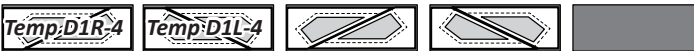
Step 11: Templates D1R-6 are placed in Bag #D1 and Templates D1L-6 are placed in Bag #D2.



► **Fabric D4: Temp D1L-4 & D1R-4**

Step 12: Cut and stack (1) 3" by 42" strip facing *right-side up*.

Step 13: The *Unit D1L & D1R Templates D1L-4 & D1R-4* are placed onto the strip. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of each Template.



Step 14: Templates D1R-4 are placed in Bag #D1 and Templates D1L-4 are placed in Bag #D2.



► **Fabric D5: Temp D1L-2 & D1R-2**

Step 15: Cut and stack (1) 2-1/2" by 42" strip facing *right-side up*.

Step 16: The *Unit D1L & D1R Templates D1L-2 & D1R-2* are placed onto the strip. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of each template.



Step 17: Templates D1R-2 are placed in Bag #D1 and Templates D1L-2 are placed in Bag #D2.

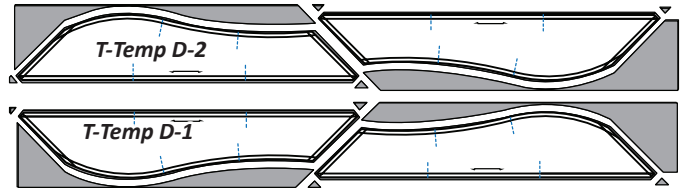
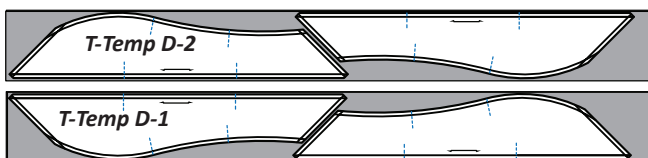


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: T-TEMPLATES

► **Fabric D6: T-Temp D-1 AND D-2**

Step 1: Cut (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips. Stack the strips into (2) stacks of (2) strips facing *right-side up*.

Step 2: *T-Templates D-1 & D2* are each placed onto one set of strips. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of each Template.

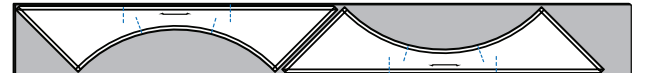


Step 3: Place these pieces into Bag #D5.

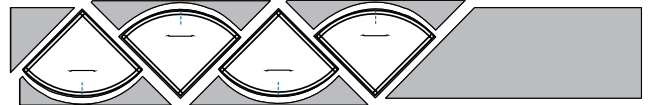
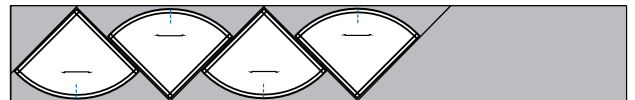
► **Fabric D7: T-Temp D-4 & D-3**

Step 1: Cut and stack (4) 5" by 42" strips facing *right-side up*. Set these aside for *T-Temp D-4*. Then, cut and stack (3) 6-1/2" by 42" strips facing *right-side up*. Set these aside for *T-Temp D-3*.

Step 2: *T-Template D-4* is used to cut (8) pieces, matching the size and shape of each Template. Place these pieces into Bag #D5.



Step 3: *T-Template D-3* is used to cut (16) pieces, matching the size and shape of each Template. Place these pieces into Bag #D5.



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS UNIT D2- D7

► **Fabric D8: (TLS) #3, #4, #5, & #6**

Step 1: Cut and stack (8) 4-3/4" by 42" strips facing *right-side up* into (1) group of strips. Set these aside for (TLS) #3 & #4. Then, cut and stack (8) 4-1/4" by 42" strips facing *right-side up* into one group of strips. Set these aside for (TLS) #5 & #6.

Step 2: Position (2) each *Unit D2, D4, D5, D7, Template D2-3 Layout Sheet #3* and (1) each *Unit D3, D6, Template D3-3 Layout Sheet #4* as shown on the (8) 4-1/4" by 42" strips.



Step 3: Cut (8) pieces, matching the size and shape of each (TLS).



Step 4: Paper clip each section to the fabric to keep the template from moving and complete the cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric on each CUT LINE to separate the individual pieces.

Step 5: The D2-3 Template pieces are placed in Bag #D3. The D3-3 Template pieces are placed in Bag #D4.
