

DIAMOND AB FOUNDATION PAPERS AND TEMPLATES

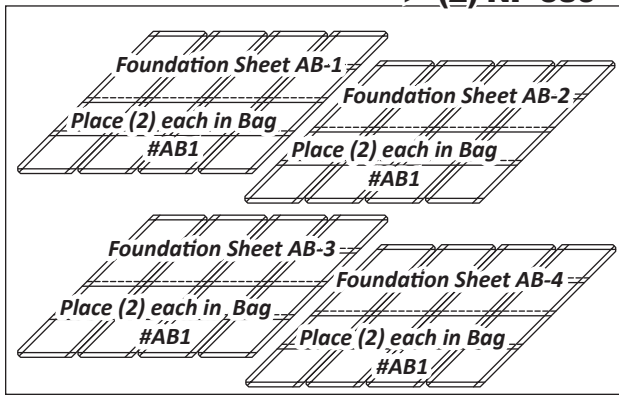
Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (1) Bag to complete the organization for Group A. Label each Bag as follows:

1. Bag #AB1, AB Foundation Sheets AB-1 to AB-4
2. Bag #AB2, Sashing Strip Templates

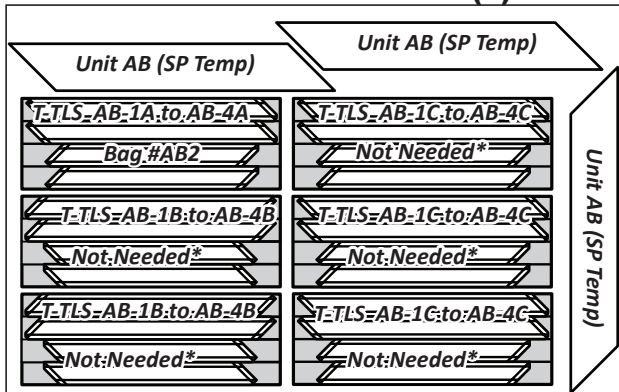
► Preparing the Foundation Papers:

Cut out (2) of each *Foundation Sheet AB1, AB2, AB3, and AB4* found on [NP 580]. Place the correct number of *Foundation Sheets*, along with the *T-Template Layout Sheets (A, B, & C)* [TP 381] into the assigned Bag #s. The *Unit AB Strip Piecing Template* from [TP #381] goes in Bag #AB1. See the newsprint graphics below for information on how to organize your units and templates into bags. *Refer back to General Information under Foundation Papers and Templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.

NOTE - T-TLS AB-1B to AB-4B and AB-1C to AB-4C: TP 381 has multiple T-Template Layout Sheets on it that are used if you use the AB block in different rounds in your quilt. You only need AB-1A to AB-4A for this quilt.

DIAMOND AB FABRIC INFORMATION

► Fabric Reference Information

The 16-Colored Diamond is used in many Quiltworx patterns. This block is called the AB block. Therefore, all the sections, units, bags, and fabric references will have AB in them.

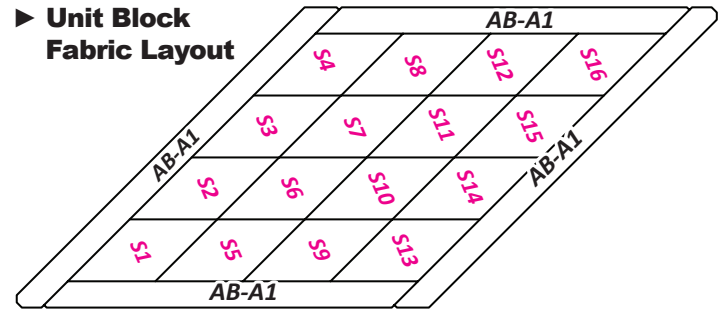
Fabrics AB-S1 to AB-S16: There are (16) single diamonds in one Diamond Block. Each single diamond in the Diamond Block is assigned its own Fabric #AB-S1 to AB-S16. A Unit Block Fabric layout showing where each Diamond goes is provided in the next

column. A Unit Chart with yardage for each fabric is also shown below. The graphic below shows the FRONT SIDE of the block. In the cover quilt, all of the AB Blocks are created with the same fabric in the same places. To keep track of which fabric goes where, we recommend cutting a small fabric swatch and either pasting it to the diamond in the Fabric Layout or in the Unit Chart, or both!

Fabric AB-A1: We used (1) fabric for #AB-A1. Reference the unit chart on the next page for the total yardage to cut. Paste a fabric swatch into the Fabric Swatch box in the table where Fabric AB-A1 is shown.

If you choose more than (1) AB-A1 fabric, you will need to work with Quiltster to determine yardage. In general, (1) 5" x 42" strip allows you to create (3) diamond units. But, Quiltster will help you determine yardage without having to do the math, helping you avoid a mistake! You will need to cut extra swatches of fabric to paste next to each other in the Unit Chart if you do this.
