
## **GROUP B: SPIKED RING BACKGROUND GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (5) Bags to complete the organization for these instructions. Label and organize the cutting templates as follows:


- Bag #B1: Unit B1 and associated Template Layout Sheets
- Bag #B2: Unit B2 and associated Template Layout Sheets •
- Bag #B3: Unit B3 and associated Template Layout Sheets •
- Bag #B4: Unit B4 and associated Template Layout Sheets •
- Bag #B5: T-Templates B1L to B6L & B1R to B6R •

#### Preparing the Foundation Papers:

Step 1: Cut out (8) of each Unit B1 to B4 from [NP 631]. Then, cut out each of the Template Layout Sheets (TLS) from [TP 447]. Cut out (1) of each T-Template B1L to B8L and B1R to B8R. [TP 445 & TP 446]. Place these into Bag #B5. \*Refer back to General Information Booklet for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.



NOTE - Bag #B1: Note that all the TLS #1 to #3 should go in Bag #B1 for now. After the cutting is complete, the stacks will be separated into Bags B1, B2, B3, and B4.





The table below includes yardage, fabric references, and which fabrics should go with which cutting templates to complete Group B. This table is your guide for keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the Assigned Colors column! A graphical color layout is provided on Page 21.

# **GROUP B CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Fabric B1: TLS #2 and #3

Step 1: Cut (8) 5-1/2" x 42" strips and place them into (1) stack of (8), facing right-side up.



Step 2: The Unit B1 thru B4 TLS #2 and Unit B1 & B4 TLS #3 are used to cut (16) and (8) pieces, respectively, matching the size and shape of the TLSs. There are (2) TLS #2 to facilitate this cutting.



Step 3: Restack the pieces cut with each of the TLSs into stacks of (8), then place the respective TLS on top.



Step 4: Use paper clips along each Template in each TLS to secure the paper to the fabric stack. Then, slice through the TLS and fabrics beneath on the Cut Lines, moving in numerical order to separate the templates.




Step 5: Place the stacks in bags (See graphic above):

- TLS #3, Sec. 1 Temp B-4 & Sec. 7 Temp B-3 go in Bag #B4.
- TLS #3, Sec. 1 Temp B-2 & Sec. 7 Temp B-5 go in Bag #B1.
- From TLS #2, place (2) Temp. B-2 Stacks in Bags #B1, (5) in Bag #B2, (5) in Bag #B3 and (2) in Bag #B4.


### Fabric B2:a & B2:b, TLS #1

Step 1: In Bag #B1, there are (2) TLS #1. You will need (1) for Fabric B2:a and (1) for Fabric B2:b. If you are using the same fabric for B2:a and B2:b, then just stack your strips together in the following instructions and ignore the sorting information.

Step 2: Cut (3) 5-1/2" x 42" strips from each Fabric B2:a and B2:b. Place them into (2) stacks of (3), by color, facing right-side up.



Step 3: Use (1) Unit B1 thru B4 TLS #1 to cut (8) pieces from Fabric B2:a (the other goes with Fabric B2:b) matching the size and shape of the TLS. Reposition the TLS as shown in the graphic (2) times.



Step 4: Restack the pieces cut with each of the TLSs into (1) stack of (8), then place the respective TLS on top.

Step 5: Use paper clips along each Template in each TLS to secure the paper to the fabric stack. Then, slice through the TLS and fabrics beneath on the Cut Lines, moving in numerical order to separate the templates.



**Step 6:** Before sorting, label each stack with the Fabric reference number. So, all the Temp S-1 cut from Fabric B2:a should say B2:a. All the stacks cut from Fabric B2:b should say B2:b. Place the stacks in the following bags (see Graphic above):

- Place (2) Temp S-1 from Fabric B2:a in Bag #B1, (2) in Bag #B2, (2) in Bag #3, and (1) in Bag #B4.
- Place (1) Temp S-1 from Fabric B2:b in Bag #B1, (2) in Bag #B2, (2) in Bag #B3, and (1) in Bag #B4.


#### Fabric B3: T-Template Layout Sheets #4 & #5

Step 1: In Bag #B5, there is a *T-Template Layout Sheet #4* and a T-Template Layout Sheet #5. Remove both of these.

Step 2: Cut (2) 9" x 42" strips from Fabric B3. Stack the strips in (1) stack, facing *right-side-up*.



Step 3: Position the two T-Template Layout Sheets onto the strip stack as shown. First, cut around the dashed lines, then use your rotary cutter to carefully trim the fabric and excess paper away around each of the T-Templates B1 to B4, both Left and Right (L & R). Paper clips will help hold the paper and fabrics together.



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


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
