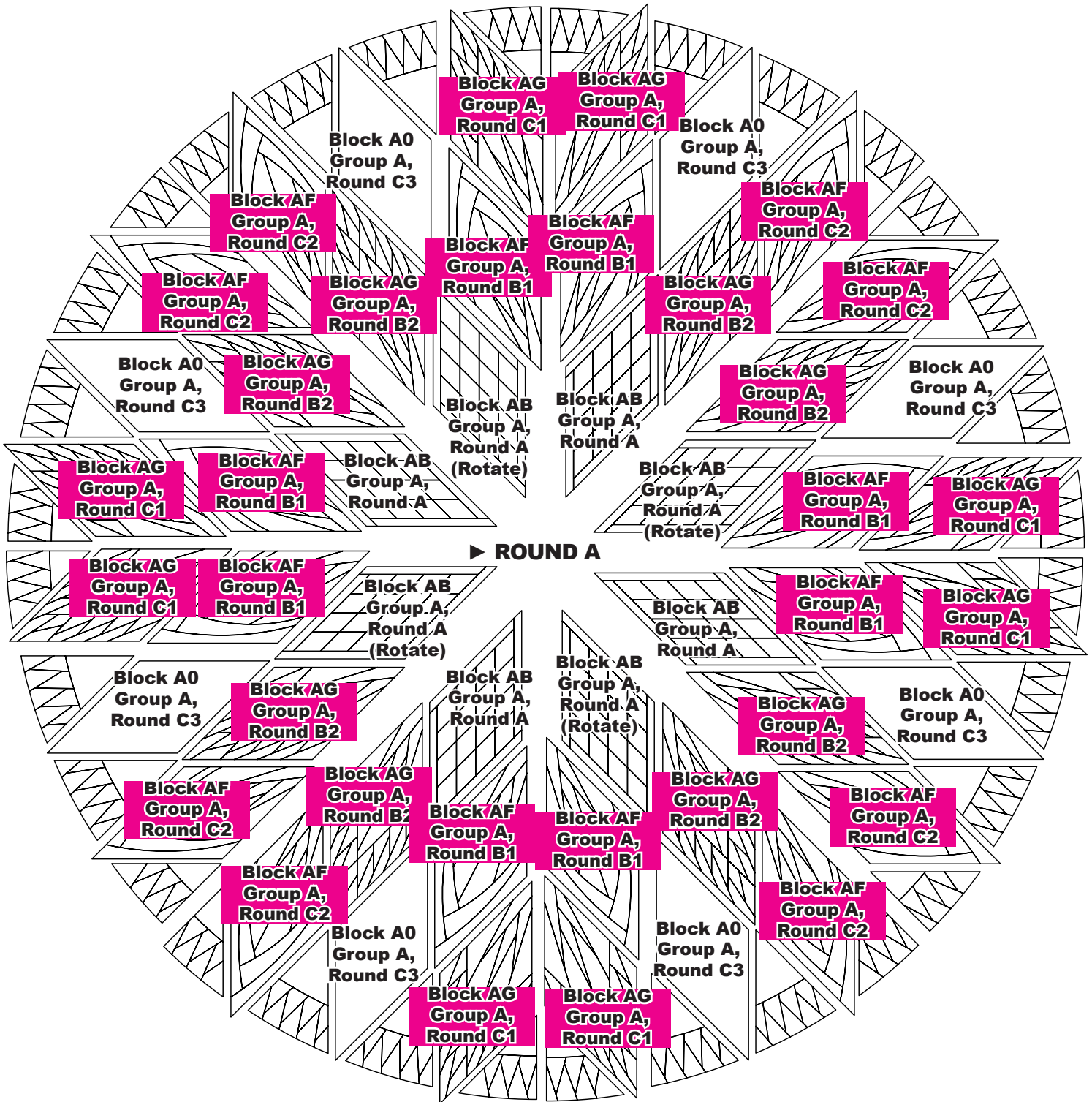


BLUE LAGOON BLOCK AND T-TEMPLATE LAYOUT

The Blocks below can be used as a guide to place your finished units as you prepare to assemble your quilt. If you are referencing the quilt on the coversheet, please rotate the coversheet so it is oriented as shown below. Note that in Round A, Group A, every other block is rotated. The rest of the block information shown here simply helps you place your blocks before you sew them together.



NOTE - Oops!: The first time this graphic was built, the blocks were rotated around the center improperly for Group A Round B1, B2, C1, and C2. The layout has been corrected and the blocks have been relabeled. I don't know what we were thinking. :-) This diagram is correct!
