### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAG #CS6-1

#### ► Fabric CS6-1:a to CS6-1:u

**Step 1:** Count up the total # of blocks you plan to make from each fabric you have selected.

**Step 2:** If you are making your own color arrangement, cut (1) 7-3/4" x 42" strip for every (6) Unit CS6 you plan to make with the same background fabric (for example):

- (6) or less Unit CS6 = (1) 7-3/4" x 42" Strip
- (7) to (12) Unit CS6 = (2) 7-3/4" x 42" Strips
- (13) to (18) Unit CS6 = (3) 7-3/4" x 42" Strips
- (19) to (24) Unit CS6 = (4) 7-3/4" x 42" Strips
- (25) to (30) Unit CS6 = (5) 7-3/4" x 42" Strips
- And so forth, for every (6) Unit CS6 made with the same background, add another strip. You could have up to (20) strips (if Fabric CS6-1 is the same fabric for each unit) to complete the entire quilt.

**Step 3:** If you are following the cover sample, you will need (1) 7-3/4" x 42" strip for the following:

- Fabrics CS6-1:a and CS6-1:s are the same fabric and you will only need (1) 7-3/4" x 42" strip to make these blocks. Make a total of (4) Units.
- CS6-1:d (Make 4)
- CS6-1:e (Make 5)
- CS6-1:f (Make 6)
- CS6-1:p (Make 6)
- CS6-1:q (Make 5)
- CS6-1:r (Make 4)

**Step 4:** For the cover sample, you will also need (2) 7-3/4" x 42" strips for the following:

- Fabrics CS6-1:b, CS6-1:c, CS6-1:t, and CS6-1:u are cut from the same fabric. Make a total of (8) Units.
- CS6-1:g (Make 7)
- CS6-1:h (Make 8)
- CS6-1:i (Make 9)
- CS6-1:j (Make 10)
- CS6-1:k (Make 10)
- CS6-1:l (Make 10)
- CS6-1:m (Make 9)
- CS6-1:n (Make 8)
- CS6-1:o (Make 7)
