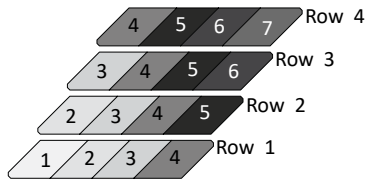

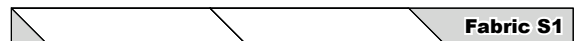

<u>Fabric S3:c</u> SP Temp	<u>1/2 yd</u> (15")	PASTE SWATCH
<u>Fabric S4:c</u> SP Temp	<u>5/8 yd</u> (20")	PASTE SWATCH
<u>Fabric S5:c</u> SP Temp	<u>1/2 yd</u> (15")	PASTE SWATCH
<u>Fabric S6:c</u> SP Temp	<u>3/8 yd</u> (10")	PASTE SWATCH
<u>Fabric S7:c</u> SP Temp	<u>1/4 yd</u> (5")	PASTE SWATCH

## CUTTING 2-1/2" STRIPS: GROUP A, B, & C

**Strip Sizes:** The cut size for each strip is 2-1/2" by 42". After the strips are cut, press and stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. Position the **Strip Piecing Template** onto the top of each stack, cut (1) stack of pieces, then reposition and cut a second stack. Restack the fabrics by color as described for each Fabric group below. Set aside the end pieces of each strip. You may need them if you make a cutting mistake. Sub-bags for each color group may be helpful, too.

1. **Color Group-A:a:** Cut (1) strip from Fabric S1:a
2. **Color Group-C:b:** Cut (1) strip from Fabric S1:b
3. **Color Group-C:c:** Cut (2) strips from Fabric S1:c
4. **Restack the cut strips as follows:** (2) Fabric S1:a on top, (2) Fabric S1:b, then (3) Fabric S1:c on the bottom. Label the stacks as S1.



1. **Color Group-A:a:** Cut (2) strips from Fabric S2:a
2. **Color Group-C:b:** Cut (2) strips from Fabric S2:b
3. **Color Group-C:c:** Cut (4) strips from Fabric S2:c
4. **Restack the cut strips into (2) stacks as follows:** (2) Fabric S2:a on top, (2) Fabric S2:b, then (4) Fabric S2:c on the bottom. Label the stacks as S2.
