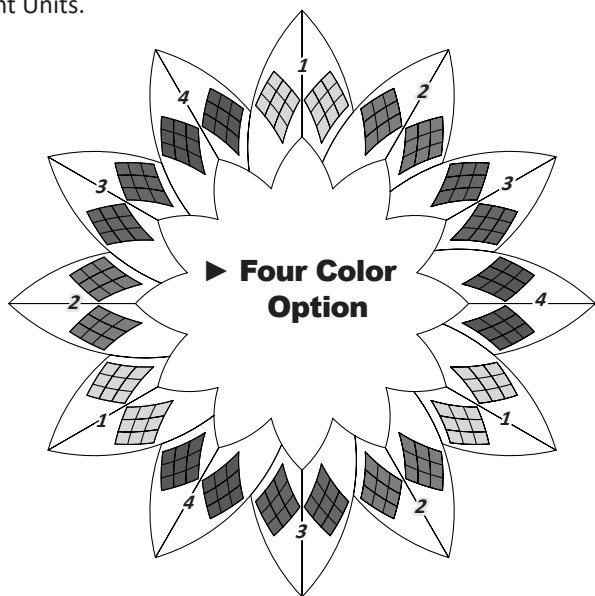


### ► Four Color Option: Cutting Instructions

If you used Quiltster to color your quilt using the Four Color Option, only cut (1) Strip Piecing Template for each assign color for each color option. The fabrics are stacked in the sewing order to match the papers. Follow the strip piecing instructions on Page 10, for each Color Option. Repeat the cutting and piecing for the Right Units.

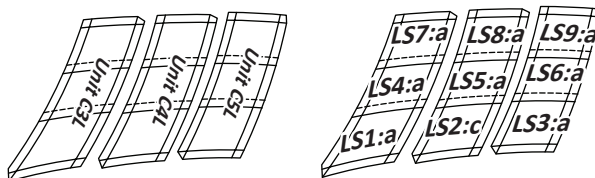
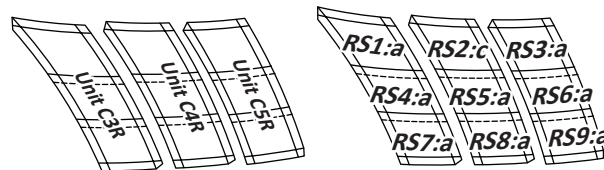


### ► Six Color Option: Cutting Instructions

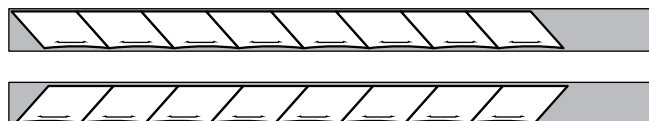
If you used Quiltster to color your quilt using the Six Color Option, you will need to cut all your Foundation Sheets apart into single units. Each color group is repeated on two foundation units.



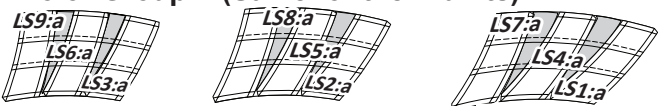
Separate your papers as shown below into (6) groups of two papers. Then, cut and paste your fabric swatch onto each group of papers as shown below. One (1) template piece is cut for each diamond. If you are repeating your colors, count the number of pieces required, then cut as many pieces as you can from the same strip. Follow the paper piecing instructions on Page 17 and the trimming instructions on Page 12.



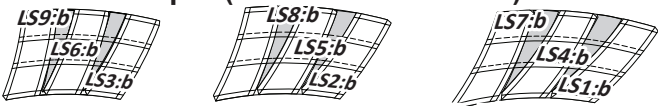
NOTE - The single paper piecing template was provided on TP 460.



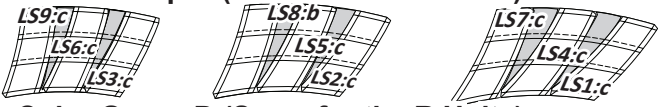
#### ► Color Group A (Same for the R units)



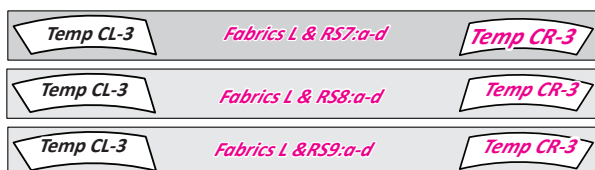
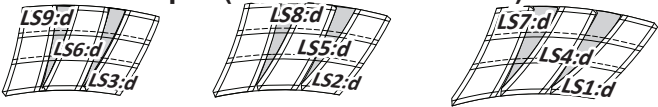
#### ► Color Group B (Same for the R units)

NOTE - Remember, (4) templates can be cut from any one color used, so when repeating any of your fabrics, make sure to make the best use of your colors.
