


GROUP G: CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Before you begin cutting fabrics, take a few minutes and cut a small fabric swatch of each color, Fabric G1-G4. It is very helpful when you paste a small swatch of fabric onto the foundation papers and their respective Template Layout Sheets. This really helps keep you organized as you complete the cutting for each of the units.

NOTE - When pre-cutting your fabric strips for the Template Layout Sheets, the pieces you cut should always measure either the same size or a little larger than the Template Layout Sheet itself.

► Fabric G1: Temp GR-1, GL-3, GR-5 & GL-7

One 15-1/2" by 42" strip yields enough fabric to cut (8) pieces for each **Template GR-1, GL-3, GR-5 & GL-7**. Additional sub-cutting is required to complete the cutting for the templates listed above.



Step 1: The 15-1/2" strip is now sub-cut into (3) 2-1/2" by 42" strips and (4) 2" by 42" strips.

Step 2: Stack the (3) 2-1/2" strips facing **right-side-up**. **Template GR-1** is used to cut (8) pieces. Three pieces are cut from (2) strips and two pieces are cut from (1) strip. Place these pieces with the foundation papers for Unit GR in Bag #G1.




Step 3: Stack the (4) 2" strips facing **right-side-up**. **Template GL-3, GR-5 & GL-7** are used to cut (8) pieces for each template. Place the GL-3 & GL-7 template pieces with the foundation papers for Unit GL in Bag #G2. Place the GR-5 templates pieces with the foundation papers for Unit GR in Bag #G1.



► Fabric G2: Temp GL-2, GR-3, GL-5 & GR-7

One 15-1/2" by 42" strip yields enough fabric to cut (8) pieces for each **Template GL-2, GR-3, GL-5 & GR-7**. Additional sub-cutting is required to complete the cutting for the templates listed above.



Step 1: The 15-1/2" strip is now sub-cut into (3) 2-1/2" by 42" strips and (4) 2" by 42" strips.

Step 2: Stack the (3) 2-1/2" strips facing **right-side-up**. **Template GL-2** is used to cut (8) pieces. Three pieces are cut from (2) strips and two pieces are cut from (1) strip. Place these pieces with the foundation papers for Unit GL in Bag #G2.




Step 3: Stack the (4) 2" strips facing **right-side-up**. **Template GR-3, GL-5 & GR-7** are used to cut (8) pieces for each template. Place the GR-3 & GR-7 template pieces with the foundation papers for Unit GR in Bag #G1. Place the GL-5 templates pieces with the foundation papers for Unit GL in Bag #G2.




► Fabric G3: Unit GL & GR (TLS #1 & #2)

One 15-1/2" by 42" strip yields enough fabric to cut (4) pieces for each TLSS #1 & #2. Cut (2) 15-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric G3.



Step 1: The strips are stacked facing **right-side-up**. Position the **Unit GR, TLS #1**, along the left side of your stack. Position the **Unit GL, TLS #2**, along the right side of your stack leaving room for four cuts with each template.

Step 2: Sub-cut (8) pieces matching the size and shape for each TLS. You will need to rotate the TLSs for each cut.



Step 3: Stack and center the (8) pieces beneath each TLS. Using your ruler and rotary cutter, slice through the paper and fabric on each Cut Line to separate the individual sections.



Step 4: Clip together the templates and fabric pieces for Unit GR and place with the foundation papers in Bag #G1. Clip together the templates and fabric pieces for Unit GL and place with the foundation papers in Bag #G2.
