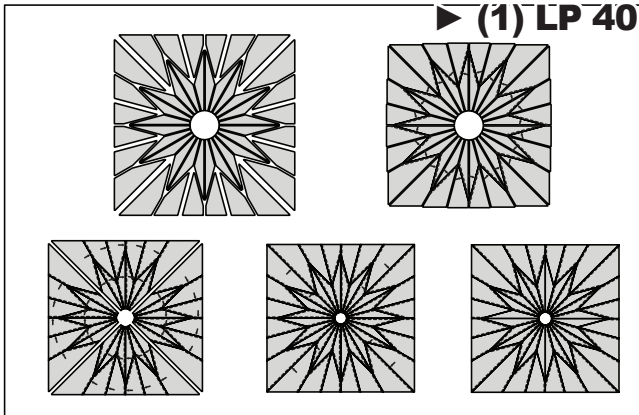
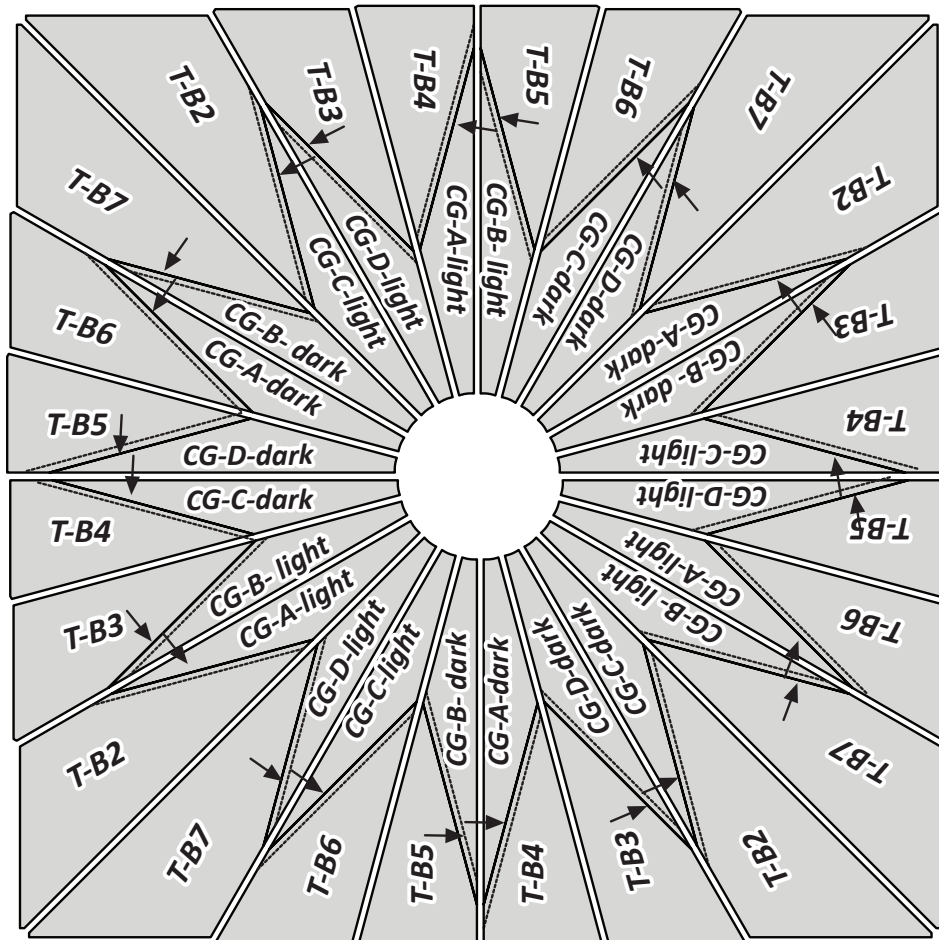


ASSEMBLE THE QUILT

Newsprint LP 40: The following newsprint includes the Assembly Graphics for Sundial. Please reference the assembly Graphics 1-5 as you follow the written Assembly Instructions below. The Assembly Graphics shown represent the front-side of the quilt.

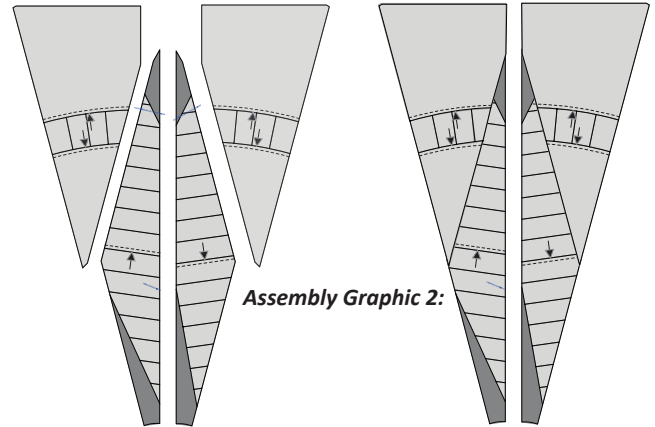


Assembly Graphic 1: Arrange the Units on your Design Board using the same color group layout printed on Assembly Graphic #1 below. The half star units are arranged on your design wall. The color rotation is repeated three times in the Sundial layout. Once the pieces are arranged in the sewing order, the Group B, Background pieces are placed in position around the star point in the Sundial. It is important to note, there are no two A & B grouping assemblies with the same background templates in this layout. Remember, each color group is repeated three times in the Sundial, but each time it is repeated, it is sewn onto a different Background Template. (GRAPHIC BELOW HAS BEEN REPLACED).



Assembly Graphic 2: Join the Star Points for Group A to the Corner Blocks for Group B. Group B is positioned onto the top of Group A. The (TRP) Lines are matched and pinned to the top seam on the Unit B arcs. The Smart Corners are matched and pinned at both ends. Then, the raw edges are glued together using a fabric glue pin.

Before you sew the two groups together, the foundation paper is removed from the backside of each star unit. The pieces are joined with a quarter-inch seam. Press the seams as shown in the Assembly Graphics.



Assembly Graphic 3: Before you assemble the Wedge Groups, make sure your pieces have been returned to your design wall in the correct color orientation shown in Illustration 3. *Its no fun to pick them out!* Press the seams as shown in the Illustration.

Assembly Graphic 4: Join the four Quarter Groups. Press the seams as shown in the Illustration.

Assembly Graphic 5: The Applique Circle is fitted in place over the hole in the center of your quilt. The cut dashed lines on the back side of your applique circle are lined up with the last four sewn seams in Assembly Graphic 4.

APPLIQUÉ INSTRUCTIONS

The laser cut appliqué circle in this package is designed for turn under appliqué. The template was cut from a product called Stitch-N-Peel. *Product Notation Below. This product is not a fusible iron on stabilizer.

► Turn Under Appliqué: Supplies

- Fabric Glue Pen or UHU Glue Stic
- Schmitz Sewing Needles, (60/8) (Sharps Microtex)
- Purple Thang
- Size 60, 80, or 100 Weight Appliqué Thread
- Small Embroidery Scissors
