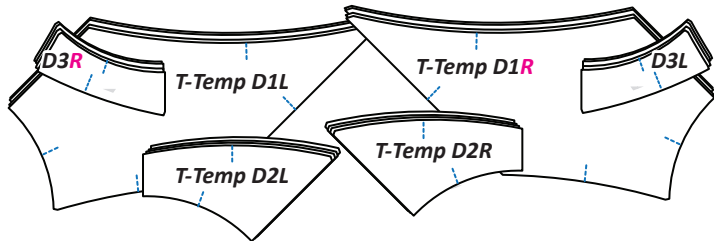


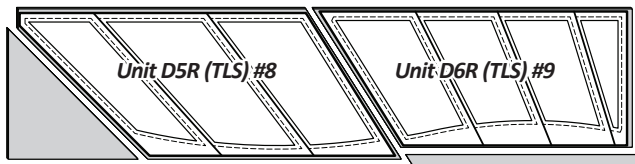
fabric. The threads are trimmed on the front and backside of fabric piece after the sewing is complete. Make sure to clip all the pieces together with the T-Template on top so you don't forget which pieces are which. Place these pieces into Bag #D4.



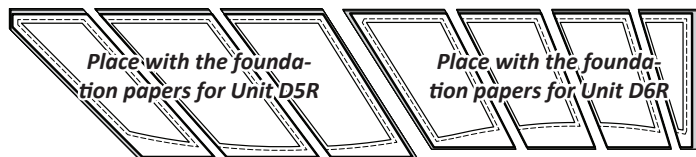
► Fabric D9: Units D5R-D7R (TLS) #8 to #10 Units D5L-D7L (TLS) #11 to #13

Step 1: Cut (4) 34" by 42" strips and stack facing *right-side up* on the table. Then, sub-cut the strips into (2) sets of (4) 11" by 42" strips and (1) set of (4) 12" x 42" strips.

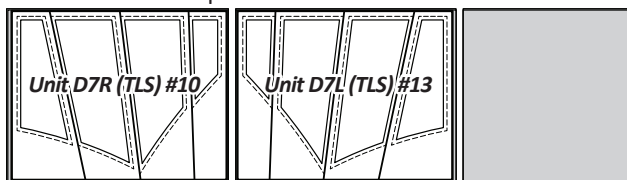
Step 2: Position *Unit D5R (TLS) #8* and *Unit D6R (TLS) #9* onto (1) set of 11" strips.



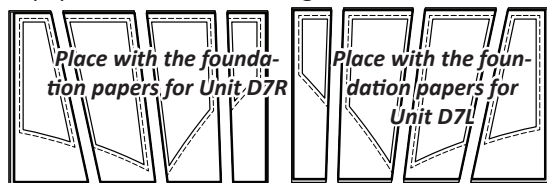
Step 3: Complete cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric following the *Cut Lines* in numerical order. Place the D5R templates with the papers for Unit D5R and the D6R templates with the papers for Unit D6R in Bag #D3.



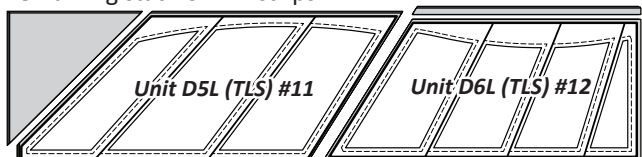
Step 4: Position *Unit D7R (TLS) #10* and *Unit D7L (TLS) #13* onto the set of 12" x 42" strips.



Step 5: Complete cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric following the *Cut Lines* in numerical order. Place the D7R templates with the papers for Unit D7R and the D7L templates with the papers for Unit D7L in Bag #D3.



Step 6: Position *Unit D5L (TLS) #11* and *Unit D6L (TLS) #12* onto the remaining stack of 11" strips.



Step 7: Complete cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric following the *Cut Lines* in numerical order. Place the D5L templates with the papers for Unit D5L and the D6L templates with the papers for Unit D6L in Bag #D3.

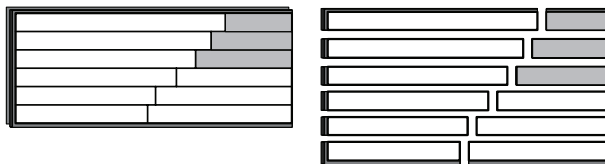


► Fabric D10: Units D5L-D7L, D5R-D7R, (TLS) #7

Step 1: Cut (4) 8-3/4" x 42" from Fabric D10 and re-stack fabric. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 8-3/4" x 21" lengths.



Step 2: Stack (8) pieces beneath the *Unit D5L-D7L & D5R-D7L (TLS) #7* then cut (8) pieces matching the size and shape of the (TLS).



Step 3: Complete cutting by re-stacking the (8) pieces beneath the (TLS) #7 and slicing through the paper and fabric following the *Cut Lines* in numerical order. Place the S-1 to S-3 templates with the foundation papers for Unit D5L & D5R, Temp S-4 to S-6 with Unit D6L & D6R, Temp S-7 to S-9 with Unit D7L & D7R in Bag #D3.

■ STACKING: UNIT D1L, BAG #D1

The stacking graphics were built using the D1L Units in Bag #D1. In the cutting instructions, your fabrics were stacked in the proper sewing order before you cut. Each group of templates you cut for Units D1L and D1R with (TLS) #1 & #2 should be stacked with (4) pieces cut from Fabrics D1:b, on the bottom and (4) pieces cut from Fabric D1:a on the top. Each group of templates cut with the Unit D1L and D1R (TLS) #3 & #4 should be stacked with (4) pieces cut with Fabric D2:b on the bottom and (4) pieces cut with Fabric D2:a on the top.

Position the templates and fabric pieces in numerical order for each unit facing *right-side up*, with the *sew-sides* aligned at the top. Sec. 1 does not have a sew side.

Stacking: The stacking process begins with the largest Sec. # on the bottom of each stack. The pieces are stacked in reverse order finishing with Sec. 1 on top. The paper piecing instructions are written for the Unit D1L. However, the stacking for D1R is the same, the section stacks are mirrors of the ones you see here.
