Iceberg Ridge Cutting Adjustments & Corrections

Applies to Kit Provided by Quiltworx, only!

CUTTING FOR B3 AND B5

When we set up the original yardage for this pattern, we used a different cutting approach for Fabric B3. that placed the grain line going perpendicular to the fabric. After making a few, we decided it was better for directional fabric and preventing stretching to switch the grain-line

For the final pattern, we have changed this, but had already ordered the yardage for the kits. The kits, will therefore have alternative cutting instructions for the B Group Chapter, Fabrics B3 and B5. We felt this was easier than trying to re-adjust the kit yardage, which would have required an extra, random 1/8th yard strip instead of the cut provided and a cutting explanation anyway.


Please review this page before cutting Fabrics B3 and B5. You only have 45" of fabric, and using the cutting instructions in the pattern, you need 46". There is, however, more than enough fabric with 45" to make this work. Here are your two cutting options.

Cutting Option 1, Illustration 1: Cut your B5 fabric first, then you will have 11" left for B3. Place the Templates on the 11" as shown in Illustration 1. There's plenty of space to get the (8) triangles.

Cutting Option 2, Illustration 2: Reduce the cut size for the B5 strips to 4" x 42". They will fit on a 4" strip. We just gave you a little extra space on each of those pieces so even if something slipped a bit during stacking, there's more than enough room on each piece. Then, you will have more than enough to cut (2) 6" strips per the instructions, for Fabric B3.

Correction for Backpage: Also, for is a small correction for the Backpage. For Tonga-B6169-Placid, D9:h is supposed to read D9:c. Please make this correction.
