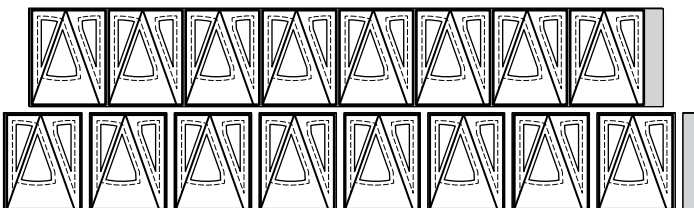

Fabric BA3 Unit B1 Temp B1-4	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd or (3-1/2")	Fabric Swatch
Fabric BA4 Unit B1 Temp B1-6	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (6")	Fabric Swatch
Fabric BA5 Unit B2 TLS #3	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (7-1/2")	Fabric Swatch
Fabric BA6 Unit B2 TLS #2	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (9")	Fabric Swatch

► **Fabrics BA1: Unit B1 (TLS #1)**

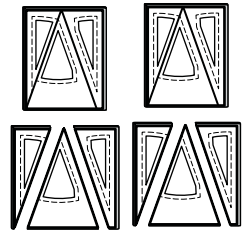
**Step 1:** Cut (1) 5-1/2" by 42" strip from *Fabric BA1*, and place facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B1 (TLS #1)* is placed onto the strip as shown. Cut (8) pieces, matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet, repositioning as necessary.



**Step 3:** Four (4) pieces are stacked under each Template Layout Sheet. A paper clip is used to clip each section to the fabric to keep the template pieces from moving in the cutting process.



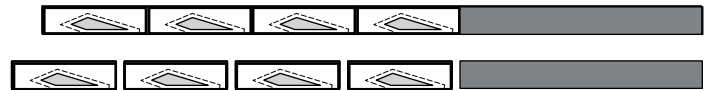
**Step 4:** The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each cut line to separate the individual sections. Place the individual template pieces and fabric beneath with the *Unit B1 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA1.

► **Fabrics BA2: Unit B1 (Temp B1-2)**

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 1-3/4" by 42" strips from *Fabric BA2* and stack facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B1 Template B1-2* is used to cut (8) pieces from *Fabric BA-2*, repositioning as shown.



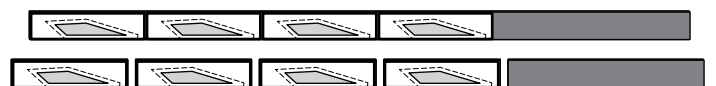
**Step 3:** Paper clips are used to keep the fabric together with the template on top. Place these pieces with the *Unit B1 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA1.

► **Fabrics BA3: Unit B1 (Temp B1-4)**

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 1-3/4" by 42" strips from *Fabric BA3*, and stack facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B1 Template B1-4* is used to cut (8) pieces from *Fabric BA3*, repositioning as necessary.



**Step 3:** Paper clips are used to keep the fabric together with the template on top. Place these pieces with the *Unit B1 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA1.

► **Fabrics BA4: Unit B1 (Temp B1-6)**

**Step 1:** Cut (1) 6" by 42" strip from *Fabric BA4*, and place facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.

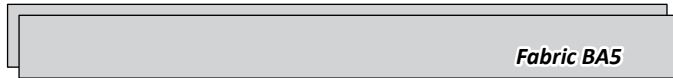
**Step 2:** *Unit B1 Template B1-6* is used to cut (8) pieces from *Fabric BA4*.



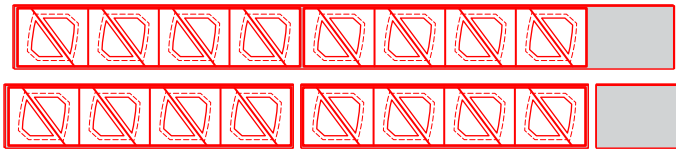
**Step 3:** Paper clips are used to keep the fabric together with the template on top. Place these pieces with the *Unit B1 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA1.

► **Fabrics BA5: Unit B2 (TLS #3)**

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 3-3/4" by 42" strips from *Fabric BA5*, and stack facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B2 (TLS #3)* is placed onto the strips as shown. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of the TLS. (One TLS yields enough pieces to make (2) *Unit B2*).



**Step 3:** Stack (4) pieces under the TLS. A paper clip is used to clip each section to the fabric to keep the template pieces from moving in the cutting process.



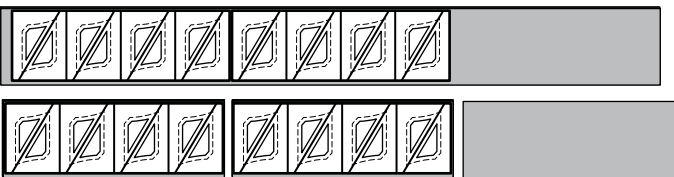
**Step 4:** The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each *Cut Line* to separate the individual sections. Place the individual template pieces and fabric beneath with the *Unit B2 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA2.

► **Fabrics BA6: Unit B2 (TLS #2)**

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 4-1/2" by 42" strips from *Fabric BA6*, and stack facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B2 (TLS #2)* is placed onto the strips as shown. Cut (4) pieces, matching the size and shape of the TLS. (One TLS yields enough pieces to make (2) *Unit B2*).



**Step 3:** Stack (4) pieces under each TLS. A paper clip is used to clip each section to the fabric to keep the template pieces from moving in the cutting process.



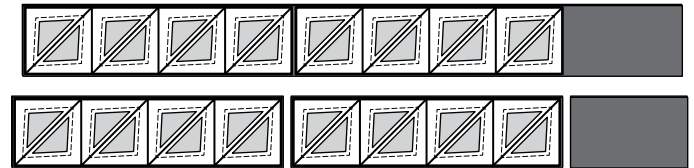
**Step 4:** The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each *Cut Line* to separate the individual sections. Place the individual template pieces and fabric beneath with the *Unit B2 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA2.

► **Fabrics BA7: Unit B2 (TLS #4)**

**Step 1:** Cut (1) 4-1/2" by 42" strip from *Fabric BA7*, and place facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B2 (TLS #4)* is placed onto the strip as shown. Cut (2) pieces, matching the size and shape of the TLS. (One TLS yields enough pieces to make (4) *Unit B2*).



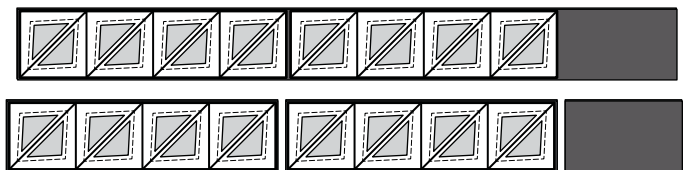
**Step 3:** Do not subcut the section pieces. Place the fabric pieces aside to cut with the *Unit B2, Fabric BA8* pieces below in Step 3.

► **Fabrics BA8: (TLS #4) Unit B2**

**Step 1:** Cut (1) 4-1/2" by 42" strip from *Fabric BA8*, and place facing *right-side up* on your cutting table.



**Step 2:** *Unit B2 (TLS #4)* is placed onto the strip as shown. Cut (2) pieces, matching the size and shape of the TLS. (One TLS yields enough pieces to make (4) *Unit B2*).



**Step 3:** Stack (4) pieces under each TLS. This includes (2) pieces cut from *Fabric BA7* on top, and (2) pieces cut from *Fabric BA8* on the bottom. A paper clip is used to clip each section to the fabric to keep the template pieces from moving in the cutting process.



**Step 4:** The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each *Cut Line* to separate the individual sections.

**Step 5:** Re-sort the fabric stacks into (2) sets with (8) pieces of *Fabric BA7*, and (2) sets of (8) pieces for *Fabric BA8*. Then, clip a template to the top of each. Discard any remaining templates. It may be helpful at this point to label each fabric stack with a Section #. One *BA7* stack is labeled *Sec. 1* and the other is labeled *Sec. 7*. *Fabric BA8* are labeled *Sec. 4* and *Sec. 10*. Place the clipped stacks with the *Unit B2 Foundation Papers* in Bag #BA2.
