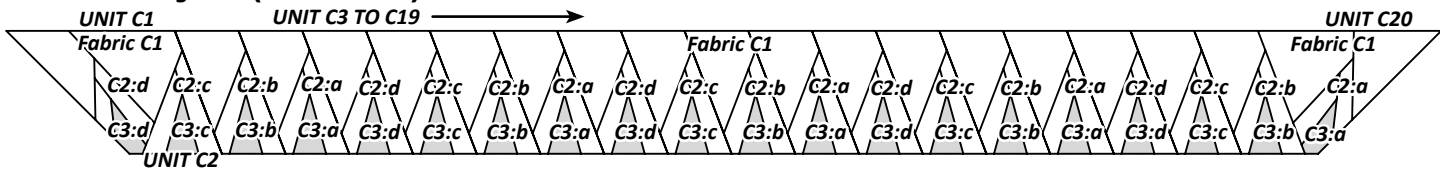
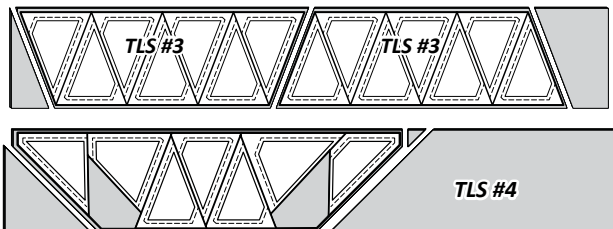


► **Color Layout (Back-side) View**

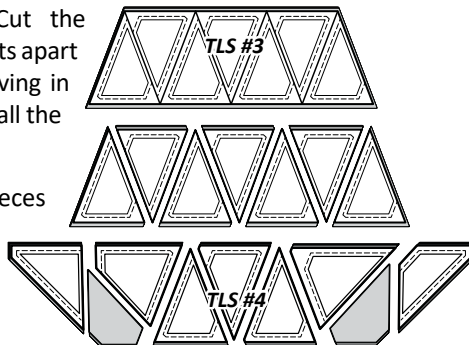


NOTE - Why the back-side view?: This view of the Fabric Reference matches the print-side of your paper. This graphic makes it easier to follow where you place your fabric swatches when you mark your papers.

Step 2: The **TLS #3 & #4** are placed onto the stacks as shown. Use the TLSs as a guide to cut **(2)** stacks of parallelograms the size of TLS #3 and **(1)** the size of TLS #4. Set any extra fabric aside.



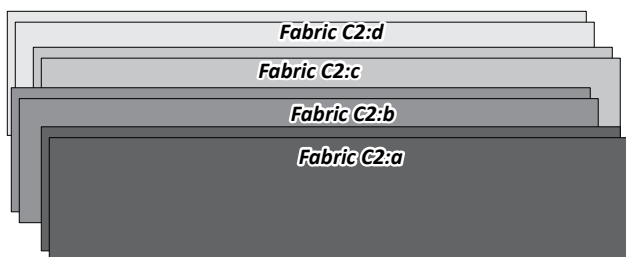
Step 3: Restack the TLS #3 pieces into **(1)** stack of **(8)**. Place the TLS #3 on top. Cut the Template Layout Sheets apart on the *Cut Lines*, moving in numerical order until all the pieces are cut apart.



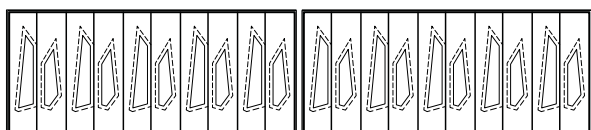
Step 4: Clip the pieces together with the Template on top and place the pieces back into Bag #C1.

► **Fabric C2:a to C2:d, TLS #1:**

Step 1: Cut **(2)** 9" by 42" strips from each Fabric C2:a to C2:d and stack *right-side up*.

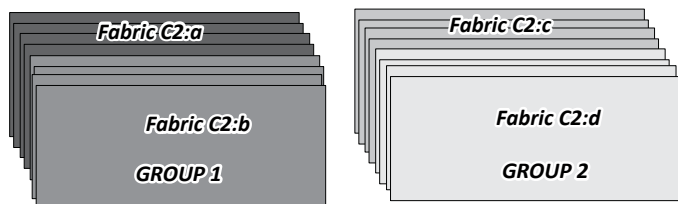


Step 2: Use the **TLS #1s** as a guide to cut **(2)** rectangles the size and shape of the TLS.

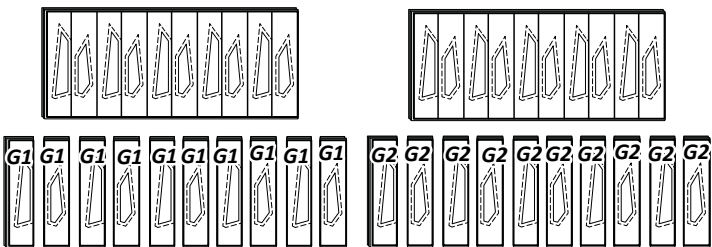


Step 3: Restack the rectangles into **(2)** stacks as follows:

- Group 1: **(4)** Fabric C2:a on bottom, then **(4)** C2:b on top.
- Group 2: **(4)** Fabric C2:c on bottom, then **(4)** C2:d on top.



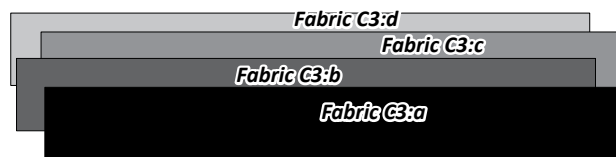
Step 4: Place **(1)** **TLS #1** onto each stack. Then, cut the Template Layout Sheet and fabrics beneath apart on the *Cut Lines*, moving in numerical order until all the pieces are cut apart. It might be helpful to label the Templates in Stack 1 as Group 1 and those in Stack 2 as Group 2, which will help you keep the stacking order correct later in the pattern.



Step 5: Clip the pieces together and place back into Bag #C1.

► **Fabric C3:a to C3:d, TLS #2:**

Step 1: Cut **(1)** 5-1/4" by 42" strip from each Fabric C3:a to C3:d and stack *right-side up*.

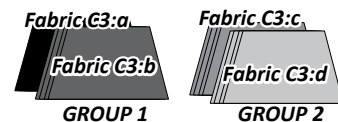


Step 2: Use the **TLS #2s** as a guide to cut **(4)** pieces the size and shape of the TLS.

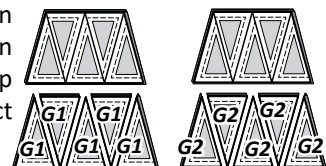


Step 3: Restack the pieces into **(2)** stacks as follows:

- Group 1: **(4)** Fabric C3:a on bottom, then **(4)** C3:b on top.
- Group 2: **(4)** Fabric C3:c on bottom, then **(4)** C3:d on top.



Step 4: Place **(1)** **TLS #2** onto each stack. Cut the Template Layout Sheet and fabrics beneath apart on the *Cut Lines*, moving in numerical order until all the pieces are cut apart. It might be helpful to label the Templates in Stack 1 as Group 1 and those in Stack 2 as Group 2, which will help you keep the stacking order correct later in the pattern.



Step 5: Clip the pieces together and place back into Bag #C1.
