

Step 2: If the fabrics were stacked in alpha-numeric order before cutting, then simply clip the stacks together and place them into Bag #H1. If not, then stack the pieces in each stack in alpha-numeric order with :a on top, then clip and store in Bag #H1.



UNIT H2: CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS STANDARD COLOR OPTION

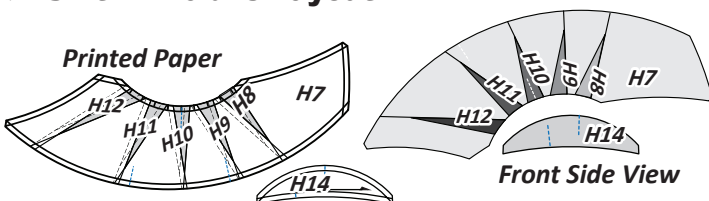
Fabric Chart: The yardage for Fabric H7 is assigned to (TLS #7) and referenced as background. Fabrics H8-H12 are assigned to (TLS's 8-12), and referenced as spikes. Fabric H14 is assigned to T-Temp-2.

UNIT H2 STANDARD BACKGROUND CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS (TLS #7)

NOTE - Alternative 2: If you are using Alternative 2, skip to that section on Page 5, instead of using these instructions.

► Fabrics H7: Unit H2 (TLS #7)

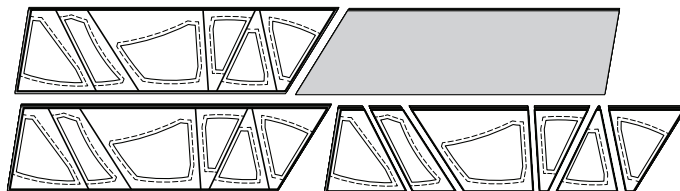
Cutting Strips: Four 6" by 42" strips cut from Fabric H7 are needed to complete the cutting for (TLS #7). Each (TLS) yields two template pieces.

- **One Color Group:** Cut (4) 6" by 42" strips, from Fabric H7.
- **Two Color Groups:** Cut (4) 6" by 42" strips, (2) from *each* color, Fabric H7:a and H7:b.
- **Four Color Groups:** Cut (4) 6" by 42" strips, (1) from *each* color, Fabric H7:a to H7:d.
- **Eight Color Groups:** Cut (8) 6" by 42" strips, (1) from *each* color, Fabric H7:a to H7:h. The (8) Color Groups will double yardage for these templates. Cut (1) (TLS) per strip.

Step 3: Stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. Unit H2 (TLS #7) is used to cut (8) pieces matching the size of the (TLS). (If you chose the eight color option, cut (1) template piece per strip).



Step 4: Stack the (8) pieces under the (TLS). For (2) or more color groups, place the :a fabrics on top and the :b fabrics on the bottom, then cut on Lines 1-6 to separate the individual templates. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath and place in Bag #H2.



► Fabrics H8-H12: Unit H2 (TLS #8-#12)

NOTE - Alternative 1 or 2: If you are using Alternative 1 or 2, skip to those sections on Page 5, respectively, instead of using these instructions.

Cutting Strips: One 2" by 42" strip cut from each Fabric H8-H12 is needed to complete the cutting for each (*Template Layout Sheets #8-#12*). (If you are working with Two Color Groups you will need to cut (2) strips from each Fabric H8-H12).

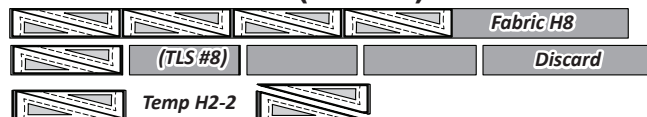
- **One Color Group:** Cut (1) 2" by 42" strip from each Fabric H8 to H12.
- **Two Color Groups:** Cut (1) 2" by 42" strip from *each* color, Fabric H8:a to H12:a and H8:b to H12:b.
- **More than Two Color Groups:** We suggest referencing the Alternative 1 instructions if you want more than (2) Color Groups.

Step 1: Position the strip or strips facing *right-side-up*. One Unit H2, (TLS) is assigned to each strip.

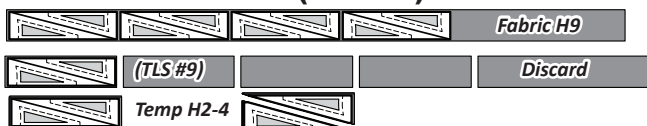
- **One Color Group:** Cut (4) rectangles matching the size of each (TLS).
- **Two Color Groups:** Stack :a fabrics on top, and :b fabrics on the bottom, and cut (2) rectangles per strip.

Step 2: Stack the rectangles beneath each (TLS) and cut on Line 1. Clip the templates to the fabrics beneath and place the pieces in Bag #H2.
