NOTE - *: The Ombre option shown on the coversheet of Booklet 6 out of Moda Fairy Dust may require additional fussy cutting beyond that shown in the cutting instructions. If you have selected this quilt, we recommend contacting Ana Blickenderfer for more information. Or, pay attention to the color shading on the cover quilt. You may want to cut apart your Template Layout Sheets in some cases so that you can place the templates on the correct section of the fabric. In the instructions, we will try and place notes throughout to let you know if we recommend a special positioning of the Templates or if you should cut them apart or space them on the fabric to achieve the look of the cover quilt.

NOTE - I'm not Copying the Cover Quilts, I'm Using Quiltster: If you have used Quiltster to create your own colorway and have worked with a variety of Alternatives for each block, we strongly recommend you make notes along the way regarding which Alternatives you choose, and whether you choose to use the lock and Unlock buttons to create more Color Groups than 1. You can simply use the column labeled as Your Quilt to mark the Alternatives you selected, and how you locked or unlocked the blocks. Fill in each space for each group with something like 2 Color Groups. This will help you quickly navigate the instructions in the following Booklets so you know which cutting and piecing instructions you should follow.
