

Assembly Graphic 7: Unit F4, which is attached to the (Quilt Block Group) is sewn onto Unit F9. The pieces are joined with **right-sides-together**. Match and pin the TRP Line to secure the center. Match the smart corners at both end points, then apply the glue along the curved edges within the boundary of the seam allowance. This will keep the raw edges from slipping in the sewing process.

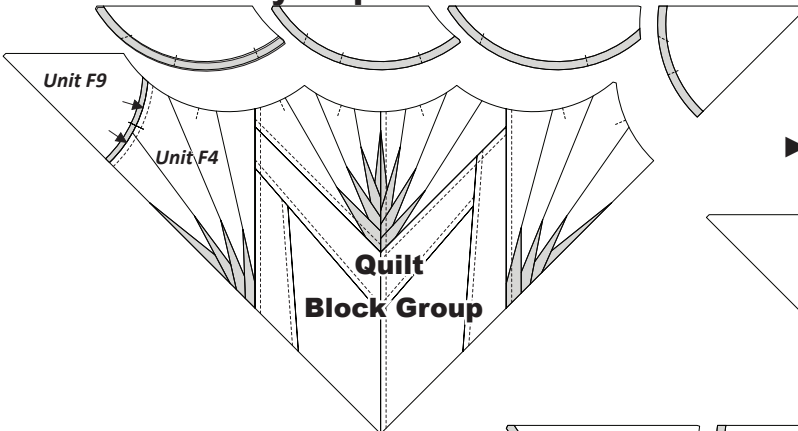
The sewing begins at the left edge, Unit F9 will be on the bottom next to the feed dogs, Unit F4 on top. After the sewing is complete, press the seam towards Unit F4.

Assembly Graphic 8: Unit F8 is now joined with the Block Group. Match and pin the 1st two TRP Lines, then match the 3rd TRP line up to the seam line. Match the smart corners at both end points, then apply the glue along the curved edges within the boundary of the seam allowance. This will keep the raw edges from slipping in the sewing process. You may need to use several pin for added strength do to the weight of the Block Group.

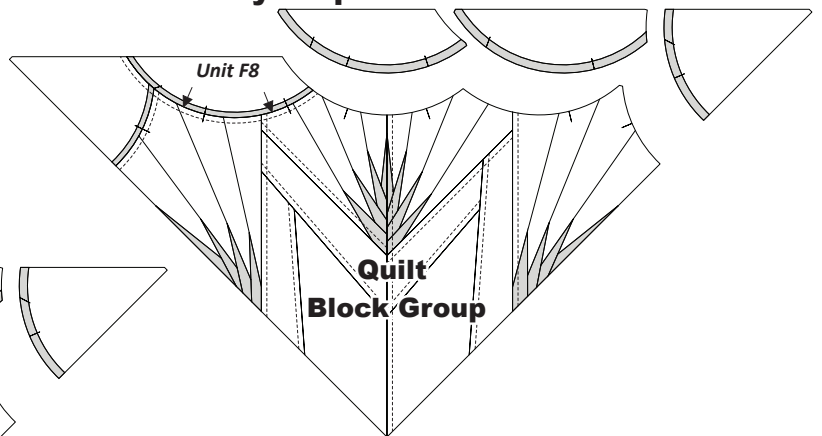
The sewing begins at the left edge, Unit F8 will be on the bottom next to the feed dogs, the Block Group will be on the top. After the sewing is complete press the seam towards the Block Group.

Step 13: The remaining units are joined in the order presented in Assembly Graphics 9-11. After the curved piecing is completed the (4) Block Groups shown in Assembly Graphic 11 are set aside until after the Thistle Queen Border, JNQ00242-D-10 is completed.

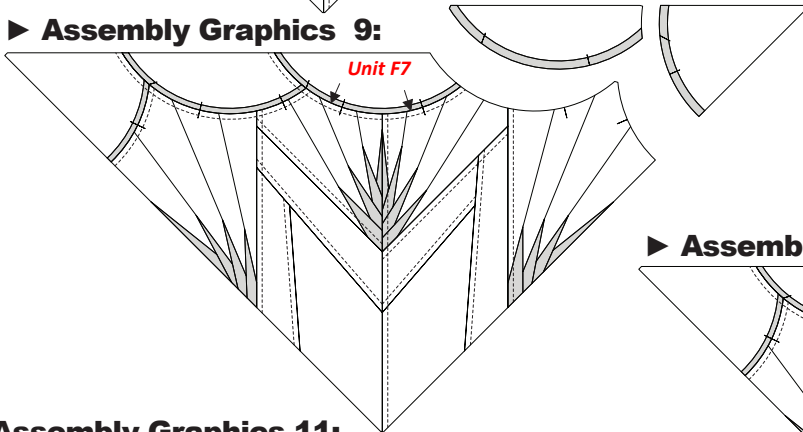

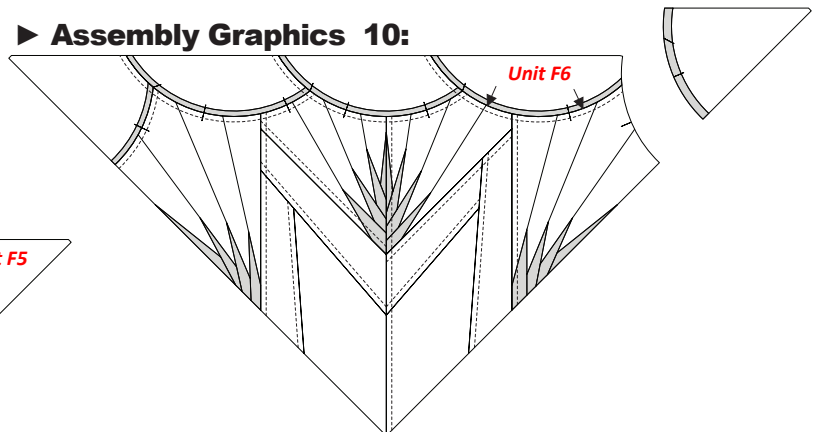
