

Step 2: Complete the cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual pieces. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath. Place the individual template pieces for units with the Foundation Units C18L to C18R in Bag #C3.

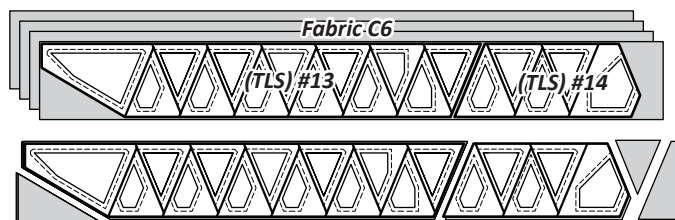


► **Fabric C6: (TLS) #13, #14, #15 & #16**

NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 11" strip into (2) 5-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

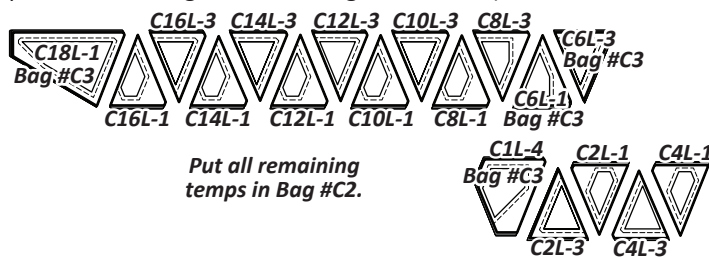
Step 1: Cut (8) 5-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric C6.

Step 2: Stack (4) of the strips facing *right-side-up*. Position Units C8L, C10L, C12L, C14L, C16L & C18L (TLS #13) on the left-hand end of the strips Units C1L, C2L, C4L & C6L (TLS #14) on the right-hand end of the strips. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of each TLS.

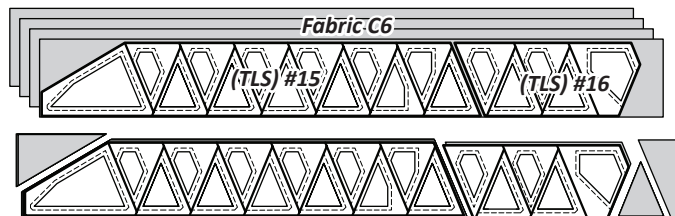


Step 3: Complete the cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual pieces. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath.

Step 4: Place the individual template pieces for Units C2L, C4L, C8L, C10L, C12L, C14L & C16L in Bag #C2 and individual template pieces for Units C1L, C6L & C18L in Bag #C3. (If using the smaller ziploc bags for individual units, first sort pieces into bags, then place smaller bags back into Bags #C2 & #C3.)



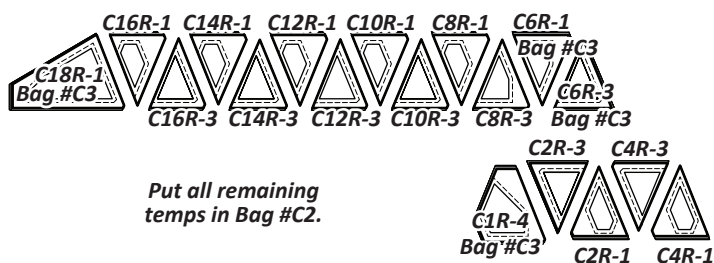
Step 5: Stack the (4) remaining strips facing *right-side-up*. Position Units C8R, C10R, C12R, C14R, C16R & C18R (TLS #15) on the left-hand end of the strips and Units C1R, C2R, C4R & C6R (TLS #16) on the right-hand end of the strips. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of each TLS.



Step 6: Complete the cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual pieces. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath.

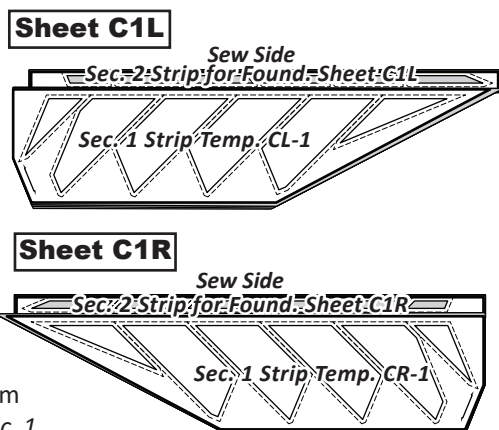
Step 7: Place the individual template pieces for Units C2R, C4R, C8R, C10R, C12R, C14R & C16R in Bag #C2 and individual template

pieces for Units C1R, C6R & C18R in Bag #C3. (If using the smaller ziploc bags for individual units, first sort pieces into bags, then place smaller bags back into Bags #C2 & #C3.)

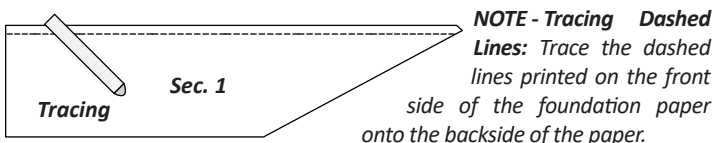


STACKING: FOUNDATION SHEETS C1L & C1R, BAG #C1

Stacking: The stacking process is a prerequisite to chain piecing. Pieces are stacked in reverse numerical order finishing with Sec. 1 on top. Position the templates and fabric pieces for Foundation Sheets C1L and C1R facing *right-side up*, with the *Sew Sides* on Sec. 2 at the top. (Sec. 1 does not have a Sew Side.) Place the strip for Sec. 2 on the bottom and the strip for Sec. 1 on top.



FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING: FOUNDATION SHEETS C1L & C1R



Step 1: Place the fabric piece for Foundation Sheet C1L Sec. 1 *wrong-side up* on your table. Lift the foundation paper, and slide the fabric under Sec. 1. Use glue to adhere the fabric to the *backside* of the paper. Repeat Step 1 for each foundation paper before moving on to Step 2. (Graphics at top of next page).

Step 2: Line the fold template up with *Line 1* and fold the paper back over the top of the fold template.

Step 3: Trim the fabric with your *Add-A-Quarter* ruler.
