## FOUNDATION PIECING: UNITS E1 \& E2

NOTE - Tracing Dashed Lines: to avoid making a lot of mistakes on these ' İracing - Units it's a good Idea to Trace the dashed lines printed on the front side of the foundation paper onto the backside of the paper.
Step 1: Position the piece of fabric for Sec. 1 wrong-side up on your table. Lift the foundation paper, and slide the fabric under Sec. 1. Glue is used to adhere
 the fabric to the backside of the paper. Repeat Step 1 for each paper.

Step 2: Place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1. Line the edge up with the solid black line marked Line 1 .

Step 3: Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template.

Step 4: Place the Add-AQuarter ruler next to the folded-back paper, and trim the fabric with the rotary cutter.

Step 5: Place the fabric piece for Sec. 2 right-side up next to the folded-back paper.

Step 6: Lift the paper, and slide the fabric under Sec. 1, lining the sew-side up with the trimmed seam allowance. Repeat Steps 2-5 for each foundation paper before moving on to

Step 7: Open the paper and sew on Line 1. The stitches should start and stop about $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ past the beginning and the end of each stitch line. Complete the sewing on each unit before moving on to the next step.

Step 10: Continue adding the remaining fabric pieces to each section on the foundation papers.

Step 11: When the paper piecing is completed up to Sec. 10, re-set your stitch length at 2.0 and sew the (TRP) Lines on each Foundation Unit. Unit E1 has four, Unit E2 has five. After the (TRP) Lines are sewn, the threads are trimmed on the front and backside of each unit.

Step 12: Trim the excess paper and fabric off around
the perimeter of the printed paper; remember to trim the Smart Corners! Place these pieces back into Bag \#E1. Note: The foundation paper is not removed until you are ready to assemble the Block Groups.

Unit E2 Assembly: The Unit E2 papers are mirror images of Unit E1. The paper piecing steps for Unit E2 are the same as Unit E1. We have added the first few graphics to get you started with Unit E2 along with a finished image. Trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of the printed paper then place the Unit E2
