


Color Options: The Standard Color Option, for the Queen border group repeats the same color through out all the units. The Alternative 1 provide the option to use a variation of color for the veins and Applique Circles. Fabric Charts have been provided for each option. Additional yardage is required if you choose the Alternative 1 option.

Fabric Chart Color Layout: Fabric J1 is assigned to, Sec 4 on Units J1-J6, identified as the vein. Fabrics J2-J4 are assigned to Sec 1, 2, & 3. Fabric J5 is assigned to the applique circles. Before you begin cutting fabrics, cut a small fabric swatch from each fabric listed on the fabric chart, then paste the swatches in the assigned boxes on your Fabric Chart.

General Block Information: The border elements for Group J are very basic. The pieces are very large and most likely will move under your foundation units so I would suggest using flower pins to help secure the paper and fabric before you begin the paper piecing. Glue placed along the raw edges where the sew-sides join will also help keep your fabric manageable.

## UNITS J1-J6: STANDARD CUTTING **INSTRUCTIONS**

NOTE - Fabric Swatches: It is very helpful to paste a small swatch of fabric onto the foundation papers and their respective templates prior to cutting out your fabric. This really helps keep you organized as you complete the cutting and sorting of your precut template pieces for each of the units.

NOTE - Template Layout Sheets: When pre-cutting your fabric strips for the Template Layout Sheets, the pieces you cut should always measure the same size or slightly larger than the Template Layout Sheet themselves.


NOTE - Repositionable Glue can be your friend when used correctly: Remember, a small amount of repositionable glue applied to the backside of your templates and (TLS) prior to adhering them onto your fabrics allows you to reposition the templates if needed.

## ► Fabric J1: Units J1-J6 (TLS #1 & #2)

NOTE - If you are working with three or more colors for the Sec 4 veins, skip the instructions below for the Standard cutting option and follow the instruction on page (5) for the Alternative-1 cutting option.

Cutting Strips: Two 14-1/2" by 42" strips cut from Fabric J1 are needed to complete the cutting for (TLS #1 & #2).

- One Color Group: (2) 14-1/2" by 42" strips are cut from Fabric J1.
- Two Color Groups: (1) 14-1/2" by 42" strip is cut from each Fabric J1:a and J1:b.



## Fabric Layout:

- Fabric J1 is used when cutting (TLS) #1 & #2 for the veins. (Standard) and (Alternative 1) options are provided on two different Fabric Charts.
- Fabrics J2-J4 are used when cutting Templates J1-J6, Sec 1-3. Only the (Standard) Fabric Chart is used for these instructions.
- Fabrics J5: Applique' circles, (Standard) and (Alternative 1) options are available.

The border graphic layout represent the backside of your fabric which pairs up with the printed side of the paper.
