

## Lone Star Border Fabric Information:

The table below includes yardage, fabric numbers, and a reference to which fabrics go with the Templates and (TLSs). It helps for not only selecting your own colors, but keeping you organized. Cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the Assigned Color column! A full Color Layout is provided above for all the Fabric \#s.

NOTE - *:Fabrics marked with an asterisk are exact. You may want to round up to make room for cutting errors.

## Fabric D1: T-Template D-1, D-2, D-3, \& D-4,

Step 1: Cut (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips from fabric D1. Position each strip facing right-side up. Position (1) ea. T-Template D-1, D-2, $\boldsymbol{D}-\mathbf{3}, \boldsymbol{\&} \boldsymbol{D}-\mathbf{4}$ on each strip. Cut the fabric between the two set of templates. Then sew the TRP Lines on each Template D-1 thru D-4. Repeat this for each strip of T-Templates.


Step 2: After the TRP Lines are sewn, trim the excess paper off around each T-Template. Place these pieces back into Bag \#D4.


## Fabric D2: Template D3-1

Step 1: Cut and stack (2) $10^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips facing right-side up from Fabric D2. Unit D3, Template D3-1 is used to cut (8) pieces. Paper clips are used to keep the template and fabric piece together. Place these pieces into Bag \#D2 with the Unit D3 foundation papers.


## Fabric D3: Template D3-2

Step 2: Cut and stack (4) 3-1/4" by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips facing right-side up from Fabric D3. Unit D3, Template D3-2 is used to cut (8) pieces. Paper clips are used to keep the template and fabric piece together. Place these pieces into Bag \#D2 with the Unit D3 foundation papers.


## Fabric D4: (TLS) \#1 \& \#2

NOTE - Quiltster App: If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each $27^{\prime \prime}$ strip into (6) 4-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (24) 4-1/2" by 42 " strips from Fabric D4. Stack the strips facing right-side up into (4) groups, with (6) strips in each stack. Unit D1, (TLS) \#1 is placed along the left edge of each stack. Unit D2, (TLS) \#2 is placed along the right edge each stack.


Step 2: Paper clip each section to the fabric beneath. Complete the cutting for each stack to separate the individual Sec Temps.
