## **GROUP C: WINTER MIGRATIONS BORDER INSTRUCTIONS**


Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (4) large bags to complete the organization for these instructions. Label the bags as follows:


- Bag #C1: (16) Unit C1 Foundation Papers
- Bag #C2: (4) Unit C2 Foundation Papers
- Bag #C3: (4) Unit C3 Foundation Papers
- Bag #C4: T-Templates C-1 to C-8

## PREPARING THE FOUNDATION PAPERS:

Foundation Papers: This booklet includes enough foundation papers to complete (1) 68" x 68" Border (noted as Group C) for the Arctic Star Mixers. The foundation papers and templates for this pattern are printed on newsprint. Newsprint is lightweight and tears away from your stitches without damaging the threads. Please pull apart this package and check, at this time, to make sure your pattern includes all of the newsprint pages listed below.

Cut out (16) of Unit C1, (4) each of Units C2 & C3, (8) each of Template Layout Sheet (TLS) #1 and T-Template C-1, and (4) each of (TLS) #2 & #3 [NP 919]. Cut out (4) each of Units CL4, CL6, CR4, & CR6 [NP 904]. Cut (1) each of (TLS) #4-7 and T-Temps C-2 through C-8 [TP 743]. Place (TLS) in a temporary bag. After the fabric has been cut, the individual Sec. Templates for the (TLS) are placed into assigned Bag #s with their associated foundation papers. Reference the newsprint graphics for the location of each Unit, Template and (TLS) along with the associated Bag # if applicable. \*Refer to General Information for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.





## **▶** Winter Migrations Fabric Information:

The Unit Chart that follows includes Fabric #s, yardage/inches, and a reference to which fabrics go with which Templates and (TLS) to make *Units C1–C3* and *T-Templates C-1* to *C-8*. The chart below is for the **standard layout** (all geese are cut from the same *Fabric C2*). This is the colorway that was used on the coversheet. If you are using one of the two alternate layouts [geese cut from (2) fabrics or (8) fabrics], be sure to use the proper table listed later in the instructions for Fabric C2 only (C1 to C4 will still come from this table below). The table is your guide for selecting your own colors and keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the Assigned Color column! A Standard Color Layout on the next page provides a visual reference of the location of each Fabric #.

NOTE - Template Reuse: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

NOTE - Repositionable Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary.

NOTE - Fabric Glue: Fabric glue is used to secure the cut smart corners and raw edge when fitting to pieces of fabric together before sewing a seam.
