If you precut your fabric strips and sorted the Fabric \#s into the cutting order as we recommended in the Introduction Booklet, then you should be all ready to start cutting your fabrics.

## GROUP B3: CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

## - Fabric B1: T-Temp A1

Step 1: Cut (1) $3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strip. T-Temp A1 is used to cut (4) squares measuring 3-1/2". Place these pieces in Bag \#B3: (CG:a).

## Fabric B3-1:a, :b: TLS \#1

Step 2: Cut (4) 6-1/4" by 42" strips from each Fabric B3-1:a and B3-1:b. The strips are stacked facing right-side-up into (2) groups.


Step 3: Unit B3, Template Layout Sheet \#1 is used to sub-cut (20) pieces from Fabric B3-1:a matching the size and shape of the TLS. Sub-cut (16) pieces from Fabric B3-1:b. Reposition the TLS to obtain the \# pieces required.


Step 4: The fabric pieces for (B3-1:a), are stacked ten deep into (2) groups, then placed beneath one each of the TLS.


Step 5: The fabric pieces for (B3-1:b), are stacked eight deep into (2) groups, then placed beneath one each of the TLS.


Step 6: To complete the cutting, slice through the paper and fabric on each Cut Line. Clip the pieces together and place into their assigned Block Group Bags for Unit B3 shown below.


## - Fabrics B3-2:a, :b, :c: TLS \#2

Step 1: Cut (4) 2-1/2" by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips from each Fabric B3-2:a, -2:b, \& -2:c. Stack the strips facing right-side-up into three color groups.


Step 2: Unit B3, Template Layout Sheet \#2 is used to sub-cut (12) pieces matching the size and shape of the TLS from each color. Reposition the TLS and cut (3) stacks from each strip stack of (4).


Step 3: The (12) fabric pieces cut from each color are stacked beneath one each of the TLS.


Step 4: To complete the cutting, slice through the paper and fabric on each Cut Line. You should have (36) single templates pieces from each fabric color.


Step 5: Divide the template pieces in each color into two stacks. One stack with (20) pieces and One stack with (16) pieces. Clip the pieces together and place the stacks with (20) pieces in Bag \#B1 and the stacks with (16) pieces in Bag \#B2.


## - Fabric B3-3: Temp B3-5

Step 1: Cut and stack (3) 9" by 42" strips from Fabric B3-3. Position the strips facing right-side-up. Sub-cut the strips into two $21^{\prime \prime}$ by $9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and place into one stack.


Step 2: Arrange the (6) Unit B3, Temp B3-5 templates as shown. Repositionable fabric glue is placed on the backside of each template. The backside of each template is then placed against
 the right-side of the fabric.

Step 3: To complete the cutting, trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of each Sec. Temp. Clip the pieces together Place (20) pieces in Bag \#B1 and (16) pieces in Bag \#B2.
