
Fabric Confetti ~ Digitized Embroidery

DIGITIZED EMBROIDERY DESIGN BY **FABRIC CONFETTI**

Vanessa Fromm, from Fabric Confetti has created a digitized embroidery design that can be added to the Trailing Vines and Flower Basket designs. This pattern can be downloaded at Quiltworx.com, or purchased directly from the Fabric Confetti website. You MUST have sewing machine capable of reading her embroidery files to use this approach. It will also help to review the product listing for Hoop Size information as well.

Using the Stitch-N-Peel Shapes as Cutting Guides:

Detailed information for preparing your applique pieces using the Stitch-n-Peel shapes is included in the Embroidery Pattern by Fabric Confetti. If you plan to use the Stitch-n-Peel shapes to prepare your fabric for digitized embroidery, they will only serve as a cutting template. You will need to put a fusible facing product onto the back of your strips, then place your Stitch-N-Peel pieces and cut around them to the EXACT size of the Stitch-N-Peel shape. Then, you will follow Vanessa's pattern regarding applying your placement lines, using the grid system, placing your pieces, ironing them in place, and stitching out your embroidery.



Cutting your Own Applique using a Cutting Machine: Vanessa also includes all the files to cut your fabrics using a cutting machine. If you plan to use this option, don't cut your strips as recommended on Page 15. Instead, use your vardage to cut the size pieces she recommends in her instructions. For this process, you will cut small rectangles from your fabrics and position them on your cutting machine base. If you have already cut your strips, just do your best to follow her cutting recommendations for the cutting files. Save your scraps for the rest of the quilt, because you might be able to get a lot of your fabrics from other pieces as well! Either way, you should have more than enough fabric to complete the applique for this project.

Review your Fabric Confetti Pattern and the Associated Video Prior to Starting your Applique:

We strongly recommend reviewing all of the elements of your Fabric Confetti pattern and watching the video that Vanessa has prepared for you as part of the Worx Session training series if this if your first time doing Digitized Embroidery. It is a wonderful embellishment and the technique is so perfect and compatible with Quiltworx patterns! But, there are some special products and important steps you should take to achieve the greatest outcome and Vanessa does a great job of explaining these details both in her pattern and in demonstration.

Applique Grid Lines: New to this pattern, Quiltworx has added Applique Grid Lines to our Foundation papers. If you stitch these on with a Basting Stitch (in a different colored thread from your TRP Lines so you remember which is which), it is a breeze to line up your applique with your foundation papers. Vanessa has provided files that could be printed for this in the past, but you do not need to do a special printing any longer. Just use the LP 84, 85, and 86 sheets with the grid lines on them, and the AGL lines to get everything to perfectly fit together! You will love these little guides for perfect placement of your applique pieces!
