
Pressing the Center of the Star: The last four seams are pressed counterclockwise on the back side of the quilt. Before you can press the last four seams you will need to pick back the stitches to meet the last cross seam sewn on each of the eight seams that

intersected in the center of your quilt. This vou to press the counterclockwise on the back side of the quilt, which takes the bulk out of the center star. The Tweaking Diagram was built to show the seams on the backside of the guilt a pressed counterclockwise (while they are shown clockwise on LP 106, looking at the pressing from the front side of your quilt).



Backing & Batting: You will need (3) 88" lengths (how much excess to leave on each side of the guilt is personal preference, but we aim for 6" to 8" around the perimeter) for the backing of your quilt, for a total of 7-3/8 yards. Quiltworx.com recommends Hobbs 80/20 (full size) batting on a roll or similar to get a thin but flexible finish to the quilt.

DOUBLE-FOLDED BINDING INFORMATION

After the quilt top has been quilted, you can add the binding. Quiltworx.com recommends a 2-1/2" strip, ironed in half lengthwise, then sewn to the front of the guilt and hand-stitched down to the backside. The 80" x 80" layout requires (9) strips, for a total yardage of 22-1/2". Since this is an exact amount, we suggest rounding the binding up to 3/4 yard of fabric.

■ INCREASING THE SIZE OF YOUR QUILT

The coversheet shows what your quilt would look like if you added a king-size border (118" Square). While you can choose from different borders from Quiltworx, the border shown on the cover is the Wagon Wheel King Border, which is referenced as JNQ00277-H-001. You can purchase this product separately by going to the Heather in the Highlands listing on the Quiltworx Website. Click Buy Now, and find the referenced border.

If you would like to try a different option, there are others and the list will also continue to grow. A Yardage chart is shown below left for the king-size version shown on the cover if you would like to make this exact colorway.

Complete the assembly on LP 107 through Assembly Graphic 9. Then reference King Assembly Graphics 1 to 3 on the next page to add the borders. Press in the direction of the arrows.
