Step 1: BAG #5: From the 14" x 42" strip, cut the following background pieces, clip together by size, and place into Bag #5:

- (4) 4-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips
- (4) 3-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips
- (1) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip
- (4) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares



Step 2: BAG #5: From the 12-1/2" x 42" strip, cut the following background pieces, clip together by size, and place into Bag #5:

- (8) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips
- (4) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips
- (3) 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips



Step 3: BAGS #3 and #4: Stack the (7) 9-1/2" x 42" strips right-side-up. Cut (5) 9-1/2" x 8-1/4" rectangles from (6) strips and (2) from (1) strip for a total of (32) rectangles.

Step 4: Restack the 9-1/2" x 8-14" rectangles into (4) stacks of (8) rectangles. Remove the (2) Unit C Template Layout Sheets from each Bag #3 and Bag #4. Place (1) onto each stack.






Step 5: Cut on the Cut Lines, in order, to cut the Template

Layout Sheet and fabrics apart. Clip each stack together, with the template on the top and place two stacks of each Section into Bag #3 and two stacks of each Section into Bag #4.

Step 6: BAGS #1 and #2: Stack the (4) 5-1/4" x 42" strips, right-side-up, and place the **PPW Unit A & B Background Template** Layout Sheet from Bag #1 onto the stack, as far to the left as possible. Cut a stack of parallelograms to the same size as the Template Layout Sheet. Then pick up the Template layout Sheet up and move it to the second position and cut another stack. You will have 8 pieces when the cutting is complete.



Step 7: Restack parallelograms, right-side-up and place the PPW Unit A & B Background Template Layout Sheet on top.



Step 8: Begin cutting the stack apart on the Cut Lines, in order, until you have cut

the entire Template Layout Sheet and fabrics beneath apart.


Step 9: Clip each stack together. Place (2) *Template B-1* stacks, (2) Template A-2 stacks, and (2) Template B-3 stacks into each of Bags #1 and #2.

Step 10: Stack the (2) 4-1/2" x 42" strips right-side-up and sub-cut (8) 4-1/2" x 5" stacks of rectangles. Stack these into (2) stacks of (8) pieces, right-side up. Using Template D from Bags #1 and #2 as a guide, cut (32) triangles. Watch for Smart Corners! Place (16) pieces in Bag #1, clipped to a Template D and (16) pieces in Bag #2,

clipped to a *Template D*.

Step 1: BAG #5: Cut **(4)** 4-1/2" x 66" pieces along the selvage length of the fabric for the Borders of the Quilt. Place these into Bag #5. Final cutting of these pieces to prepare them for Mitered Corner assembly is described in the Adding the Borders section of this pattern.



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRIC #C3

Step 1: BAG #1 and #2: Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric #C3. Stack these right-side-up.
