
Cattails in the Meadow:

A Special Reclaimed West Release



Color Placement: The information above shows the placement for each of the colors in the pattern. The yardage chart on Page 4 shows which bags, templates, and colors go with each fabric. It also gives you yardage if you want to cut all of the accent colors from different fabrics. To keep track of what you have chosen for each location, you can cut a small swatch from each fabric and glue this into the Fabric Chosen column. There are also "Fabric Swatch" boxes next to each color in the cutting instructions. In the color placement graphic above, where there are repeated units and the colors are the same, numbers were not added (i.e. All TP Units are colored the same as the one shown). This color layout is repeated around the **(4)** quadrants of the quilt design.

Chevron Border and Unit B Geese: To reduce the overal yardage needed (as shown in the table on Page 4, you can use leftover yardage, from colors A1 to A4 and A10 to A20, to cut the pieces for the chevron border and flying geese. The chevron accents could also be cut from 2-1/2" strips. We used both left over yardage and new yardage to cut these pieces in cover quilt.

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
