## PREPARING THE STRIPS

Prepare each of the (11) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip sets you have sorted and prepared by cutting them in half leaving (2) strips, each with a length of about $21^{\prime \prime}$ long. The first half-set will be stacked according to the directions that follow for Unit A, then placed in Bag \#1 with Unit A. The second half-set also needs to be stacked according to the instructions for Unit B and is then placed in Bag \#2 with Unit B. An example of one strip set that has been cut is shown to the right.

## Stacking the Strips for Unit A: Bag \#1



Step 1: The strips are numbered 1 to 8, then stacked in the order they are sewn onto the foundation paper as shown. Color 1
 is the lightest strip and Color 8 is the darkest.

- Color 4, Wrong-side-up
- Color 5, Right-side-up
- Color 6, Right-side-up
- Color 7, Right-side-up
- Color 8, Right-side-up
- Color 3, Right-side-up
- Color 2, Right-side-up

Step 3: Color 6 is placed right-sideup, under Color 5.

Step 4: Color 7 is placed right-sideup, under Color 6.


Step 5: Color 8 is placed right-side-up under Color 7.
Step 6: Color 3 is placed right-side-up under Color 8.
