
## PREPARING THE **STRIPS**

Prepare each of the (11) 2-1/2" strip sets you have sorted and prepared by cutting them in half leaving (2) strips, each with a length of about 21" long. The first half-set will be stacked according to the directions that follow for Unit A, then placed in Bag #1 with Unit A. The second half-set also needs to be stacked according to the instructions for Unit B and is then placed in Bag #2 with Unit B. An example of one strip set that has been cut is shown to the right.






